



Executive Summary


Recovered

Pakistan reported **624** new cases of COVID-19 on **06 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **316,351** with **6,535** deaths **(CFR: 2.07%)**. Out of the total **8,528** currently active cases, **787** cases are hospitalized, out of which **499 (63.40%)** are in critical condition. **7,741** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **301,288 (95.23%)** have recovered and discharged.


Daily Incidence/Mortality




Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate






Daily Incidence by Province

(Last 24hrs) COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province







Today, 7th October 2020 WHO country office Pakistan in collaboration with TB Program / Department of Primary and Secondary Health Care Punjab conducted a two days training for Program Directors-DHDCs & District TB Coordinators for Rawalpindi Region at Ramada Hotel, Islamabad. WHO country representative, Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Manager TB Program Punjab, Dr Saeed Akhtar inaugurated the training Session.
