



### **DAILY INCIDENCE BY PROVINCE**




Pakistan reported **1,502** new cases of COVID-19 on **06 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **341,753** with **6,943** deaths **(CFR: 2.03%)**. Out of the total **16,912** currently active cases, **1,057** cases are hospitalized.




### LAB TEST CONDUCTED BY DATE



### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




### **POSITIVITY RATE BY DATE**
