

On 5<sup>th</sup> November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala conducted a virtual briefing for the development partners in Pakistan. The WRs brief encompassed the current COVID-19 situation globally, in the Eastern Mediterranean Region and in Pakistan. In the Pakistan situation, Dr. Palitha presented the COVID-19 cases and mortality patterns by major cities and districts, current health system burden and the government response. The WR noted with appreciation that over 1 million doses of COVID 19 vaccines are being administered daily in the country. He pledged WHOs continued support towards the ongoing vaccination drive.

Dr Palitha thanked partners for their support in the COVID-19 response and requested them to continue supporting the Government of Pakistan response.
