





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,435** new cases of COVID-19 on **07 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **497,510** with **10,558** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **33,124** currently active cases **2,801** cases are hospitalized.

On 7th January 2020, WHO Country Repr Dr Palitha Mahipala met with Chief Exec

Representative Pakistan Executive Officer, Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP) Mr Asim Rauf, Director Registration Dr. Obaidullah and Addl. Director (QA<) Mr Akhtar Abbas at WHO Country Office Islamabad.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the process of COVID-19 vaccines' registration, evaluation & quality assurance. Dr. Palitha appreciated DRAP for facilitating COVID-19 treatment availability in Pakistan & highlighted the support extended by WHO for developing DRAP regulatory & medication safety systems.

WR assured WHO Pakistan will support DRAP to address immediate and long term needs for post marketing surveillance of COVID-19 vaccination in provinces and linking with Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI) reporting through DRAP integrated Pharmacovigilance systems.
