





#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **DAILY INCIDENCE BY PROVINCE**




Pakistan reported **1,436** new cases of COVID-19 on **07 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **343,189** with **6,968** deaths **(CFR: 2.03%)**. Out of the total **17,804** currently active cases, **1,067** cases are hospitalized.

#### LAB TEST CONDUCTED BY DATE




#### POSITIVITY RATE BY DATE
