





### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported **2,885** new cases of COVID-19 on **07 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **423,179** with **8,487** deaths **(CFR: 2.00%).** Out of the total **44,241** currently active cases **3,048** cases are hospitalized.
