

### **Executive Summary**

Pakistan reported 330 new cases of COVID-19 on 7 September 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 299,233 with 6,350 deaths (CFR: 2.12%). Out of the total 6,726 currently active cases, 1,047 cases are hospitalized, out of which 606 (57.87%) are in critical condition. 5,679 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of 286,157 (95.63%) have recovered and discharged.

# Daily Incidence/Mortality








#### **Daily Incidence by Province**





# **Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate**




# **COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR**

# **FLOOD SITUATION**

# Tuesday, 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020

In Pakistan, during last spell of monsoon rains, no new incident was reported in province of Punjab, Balochistan, Sindh and AJK. According to NDMA (from 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> September 2020) most of the impact of the rains and floods occurred in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, which recorded **2** new deaths due to landslide in village Mahting Yarkhoon in District Chitral, **1 house** fully damaged in district Kurram and **38 houses** partially and **3 houses** fully damaged in district Buner.

To date over **248 deaths**, over **170** Injuries have been recorded as a result of heavy rains and floods in the country. Over, **1,370 houses fully** and **1,303 partially** damaged since **15th** June. See the table below for details.


