



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,007** new cases of COVID-19 on **08 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **499,517** with **10,598** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **33,474** currently active cases **2,779** cases are hospitalized.
