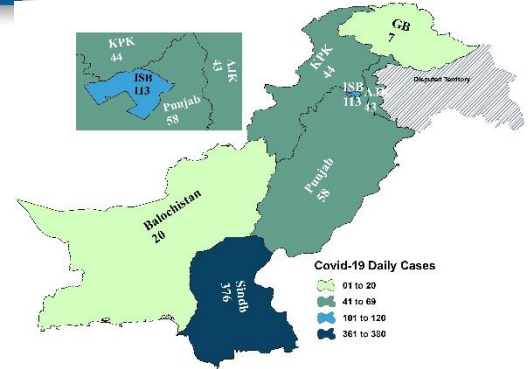

Executive Summary

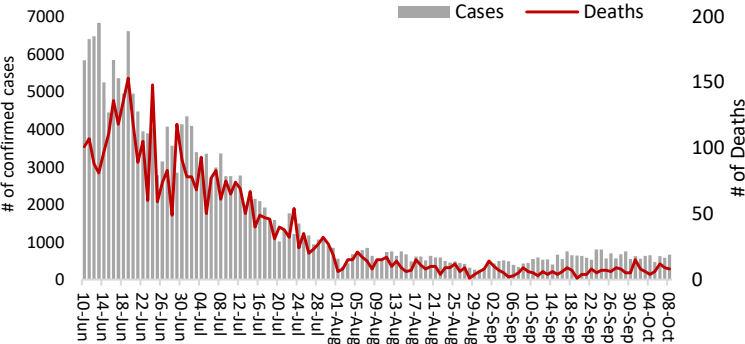
Pakistan reported **661** new cases of COVID-19 on **08 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **317,595** with **6,552** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **8,335** currently active cases, **784** cases are hospitalized, out of which **493** (**62.88%**) are in critical condition. **7,551** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **302,708** (**95.31%**) have recovered and discharged.

Daily Incidence by Province



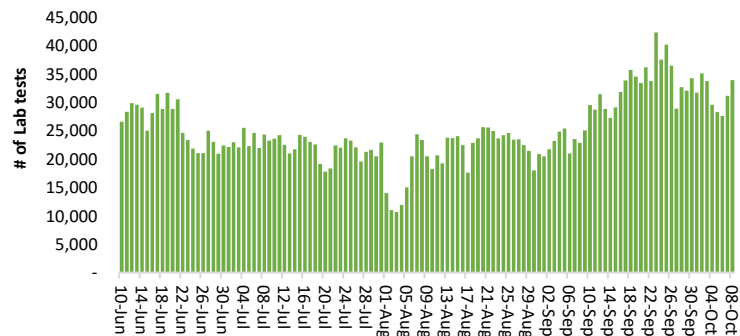
Daily Incidence/Mortality

10-Jun - 08-Oct 2020

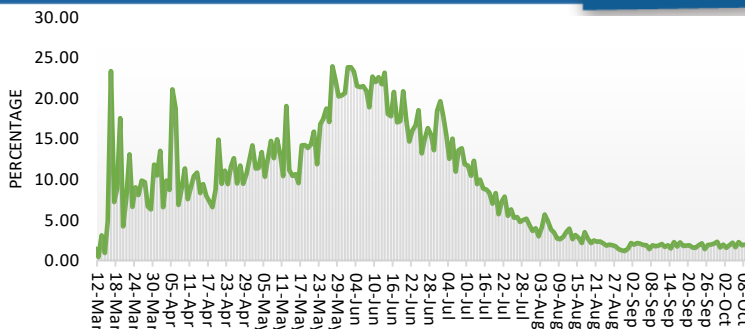


Daily Lab Test conducted

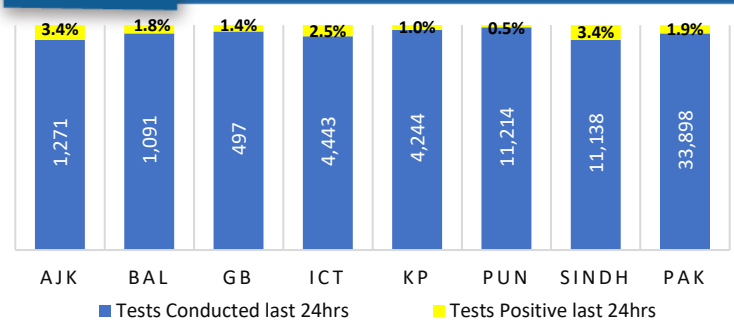


Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

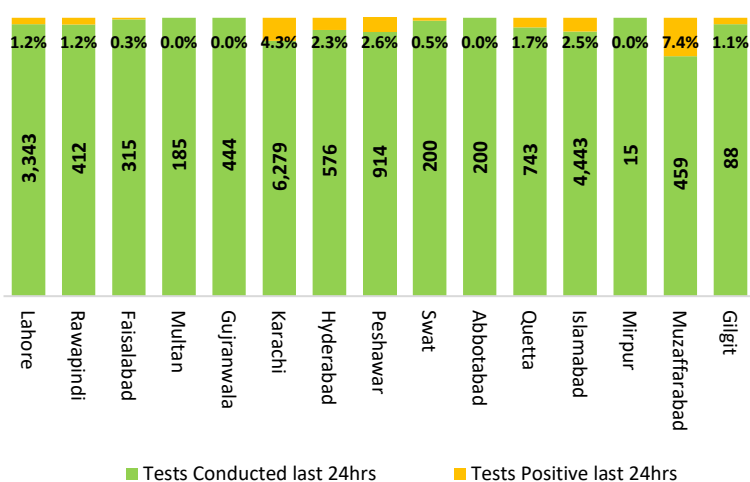
