




#### **Executive Summary**

Pakistan reported **661** new cases of COVID-19 on **08 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **317,595** with **6,552** deaths **(CFR: 2.06%)**. Out of the total **8,335** currently active cases, **784** cases are hospitalized, out of which **493 (62.88%)** are in critical condition. **7,551** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **302,708 (95.31%)** have recovered and discharged.


#### **Daily Incidence/Mortality**




#### **Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate**






#### **Daily Incidence by Province**


### COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province
