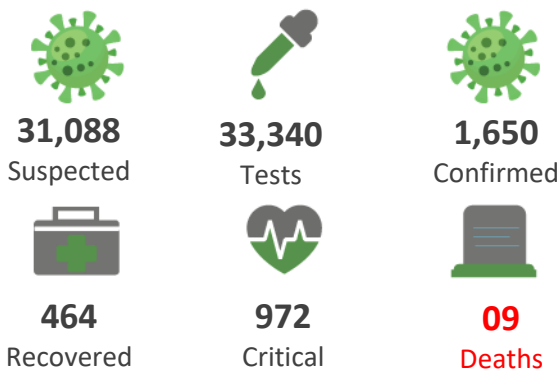


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



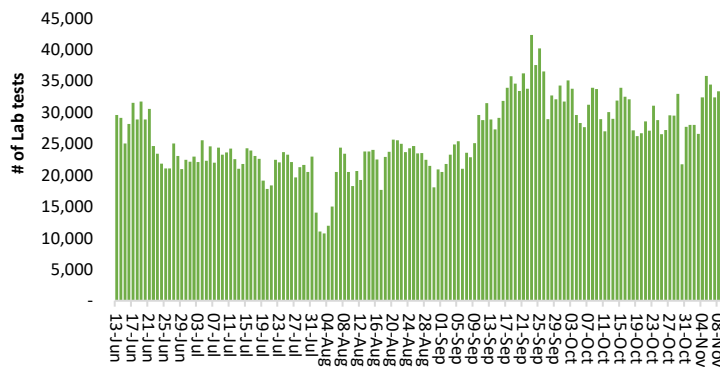
Pakistan reported **1,650** new cases of COVID-19 on **08 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **344,839** with **6,977** deaths (**CFR: 2.02%**). Out of the total **18,981** currently active cases, **1,107** cases are hospitalized.

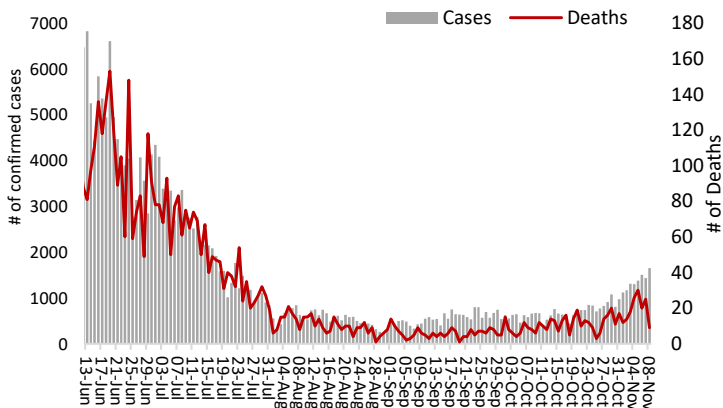

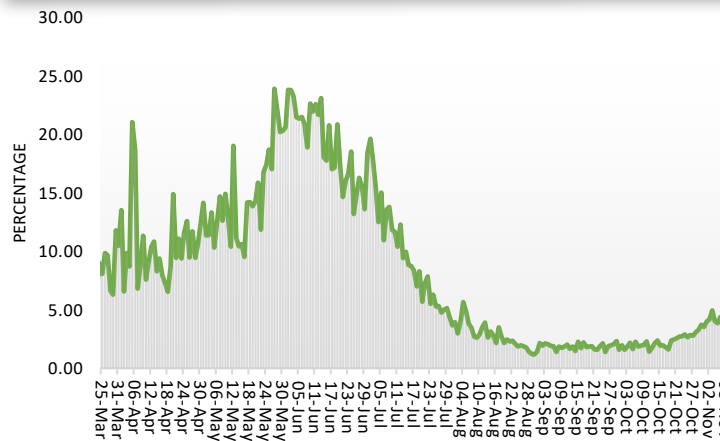


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

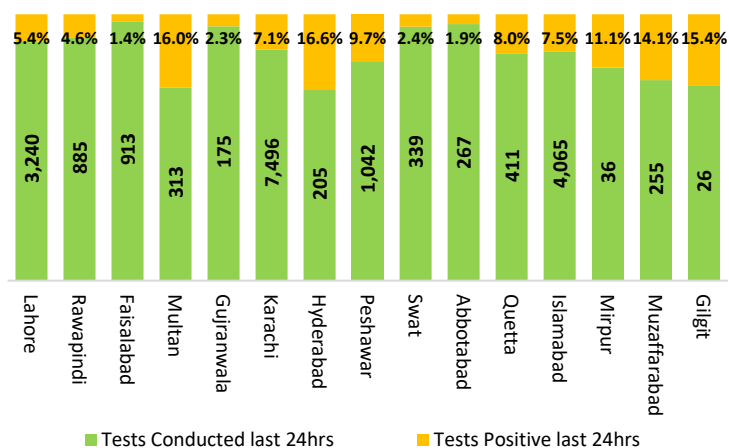
Today, 09 November 2020, WHO Country representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala, visited Peshawar to inaugurate a two days workshop on Management of Cutaneous Leishmaniasis. Dr Farooq Jamil, Special Secretary Health and Dr Mohammad Niaz, Director General Health Services participated in the inauguration.

Dr Palitha in his speech, mentioned that Leishmaniasis is a Global problem and EMRO is reporting >70% global burden and Pakistan is one of the country's reporting the highest burdens. The WR also pointed out that provision of diagnostic and treatment services to the affected is right of every person.

Lastly, Dr Palitha handed over 5000 vials of Glucantime injections to the Director General Health Services, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
