





Meetings & Coordination



On 8th December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Health Dr Faisal Sultan inaugurated a pilot project on health insurance for Outpatient Services at Primary Health Care (PHC) level. The ceremony took place at Begum Jan Hospital, Islamabad where over 1,000 families from catchment population of UC-18 Khanna Dak, UC-19 Tarlai, UC-20 Alipur/Kirpa and UC-22 Chak Shahzad will benefit from the initiative. This pilot project is supported by WHO Pakistan in collaboration with Sehat Sahulat Program and Marie Stope Society. The District Health Officer — ICT,Dr Zaeem Zia, officials from the MoNHSR&C and WHO staff attended the ceremony.

In his remarks, Dr Faisal appreciated WHO Pakistan for supporting initiatives for universal health coverage. He reiterated the government of Pakistan's commitment towards universal health insurance to its citizens.
