





#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported **1,072** new cases of COVID-19 on **9**<sup>th</sup> **February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **557,591** with **12,128** deaths **(CFR: 2.17%)**. Out of the total **30,512** currently active cases **2,168** cases are hospitalized.

## SUMMARY TABLE BY PROVINCE

### **MEETINGS & COORDINATION**

On 9<sup>th</sup> February 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan organized a virtual meeting with Mr Masao Takekida, Counsellor, Chief of Protocol/General Affairs Section at Embassy of Japan in Pakistan. The meeting was chaired by Dr Michael Lukwiya, Acting Office-In-charge WHO Pakistan.

Dr Lukwiya briefed the Counsellor on the current situation of COVID-19 including updates on the status of vaccination drive in Pakistan. He informed the counsellor that Pakistan is enrolled in the COVAX facility, that is, a coalition between WHO, UNICEF and GAVI alliance. In addition, Pakistan has also opted to procure additional vaccines for its population through COVAX facility and the Federal Government has initiated bilateral negotiations with multiple vaccine producers including Pfizer. Mr Masao expressed his profound gratefulness to WHO Pakistan for its continued support to the government of Pakistan for COVID-19 Pandemic response.
