
PAKISTAN CIVID-19 SITUATION REPORT





Meeting and Coordination







On 8th July 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala accompanied by WHO/EPI Team Lead, Dr Osama Mere, WHO head of sub office Punjab, Dr. Jamshaid Ahmed, WHO MNCH technical officer Dr Yahya Gulzar paid a courtesy call to the Provincial Secretary Primary & Secondary Healthcare Department Ms Sarah Aslam and met with the Director General Health Service Punjab, Dr Haroon Jahagir Khan, Director Health Service EPI Dr Mukhtar Awan, and Additional Secretary Technical, Dr Asim Altaf. The WR briefed the team on the COVID-19 situation and current response. He emphasized on strengthening the testing capacity, genomic sequencing for SARS-COV-2 variants and non-pharmaceutical interventions as some of the key pillars in the response.

The WR appreciated the province in successfully executing the Typhoid Vaccination campaign and called for the same dedication in the ongoing Measles vaccination campaign. Ms Aslam appealed for strengthening of the Public Health Laboratory networks in Punjab. She further appreciated WHO Pakistan for the timely technical and logistical support towards the ongoing measles outbreak.
