

#### **Executive Summary**


Pakistan reported **441** new cases of COVID-19 on **9 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **299,855** with **6,365** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **5,540** currently active cases, **1,029** cases are hospitalized, out of which **550 (53.44%)** are in critical condition. **4,511** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **287,950 (96.02%)** have recovered and discharged.

#### **Daily Incidence/Mortality**








#### **Daily Incidence by Province**





#### **COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR**



#### **FLOOD SITUATION**

Thursday, 10<sup>th</sup> September 2020

No new incidence of heavy rains and floods was reported in the province of Punjab, Balochistan, Sindh and AJK. However, in the district Abbottabad of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province; according to the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) **2 houses have been** partially damaged (from 8th to 9th September 2020) due to torrential rains.

To date over **301 deaths**, over **233** Injuries, over **12,676** people have been displaced as a result of heavy rains and floods in the country. Over, **78,469 houses fully** and **138,142** partially damaged since 15th June.


In response the government of Sindh has created **196** relief camps in different parts of province. Currently **23,629** persons are residing in these camps. See the table below for details.




