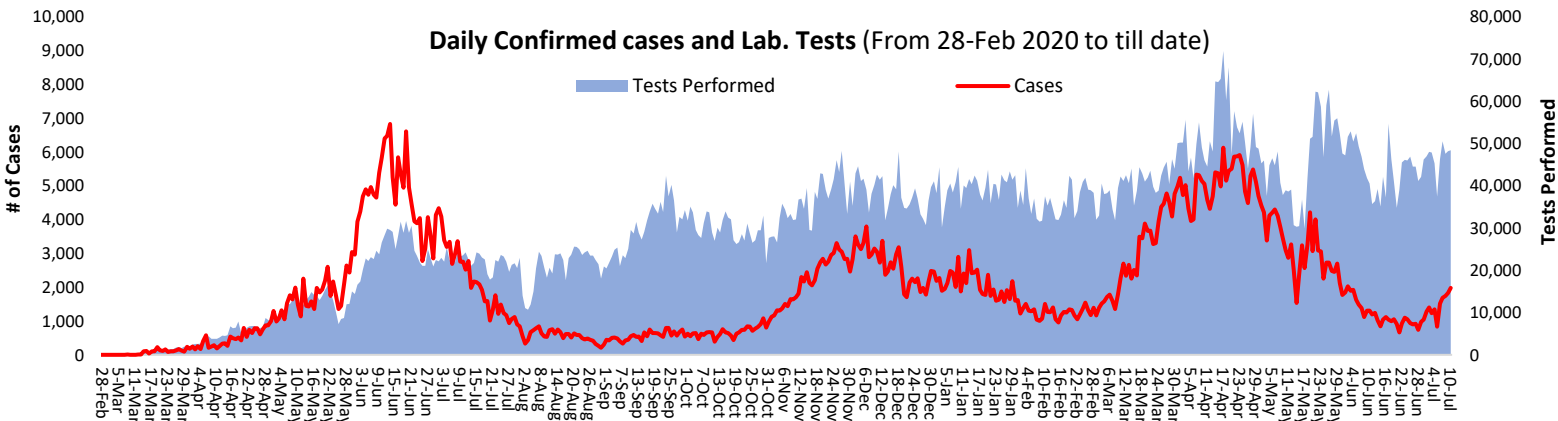

Meeting and Coordination

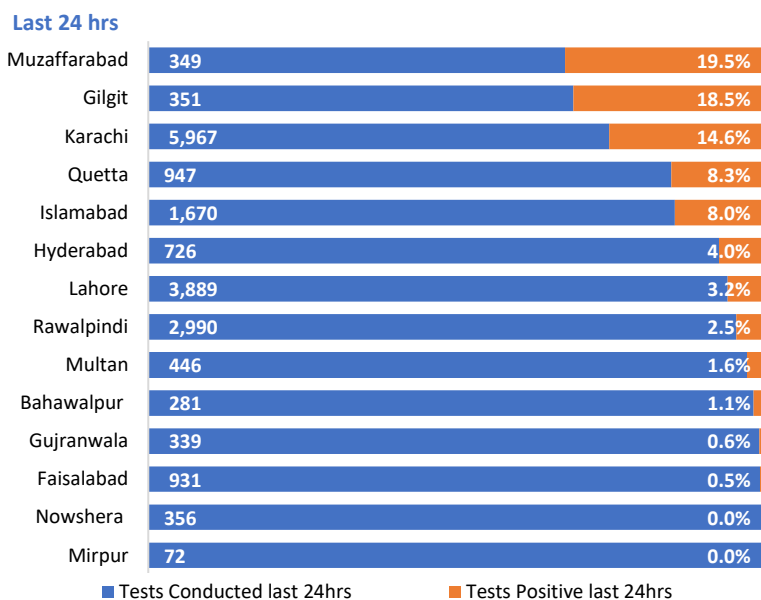


On 09th July 2021, WHO Country representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala conducted a virtual briefing for development partners. The meeting was meant to update the development partners on the COVID-19 situation and the response.

The WR also gave an overview of the global and regional COVID 19 situation and in the Pakistan case, he elaborated on COVID-19 cases and mortality pattern by major cities and high-risk districts and effects on the health system, Variants of concern, vaccination drive and the response capacity in the country.

The WR thanked partners for their valuable support and contribution towards the COVID-19 response. He requested partners to continue supporting the Government of Pakistan especially in the areas of surveillance, vaccination rollout, enhancing laboratory capacity, case management and risk communication and community engagement.
