


Executive Summary

Pakistan reported 666 new cases of COVID-19 on 10 October 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 318,932 with 6,570 deaths (CFR: 2.06%). Out of the total 8,904 currently active cases, 779 cases are hospitalized, out of which 483 (62%) are in critical condition. 8,125 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of 303,458 (95.15%) have recovered and discharged.


Daily Incidence/Mortality




Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate




Daily COVID-19 Global Updates (Last 24hrs)




Daily Incidence by Province


COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province
