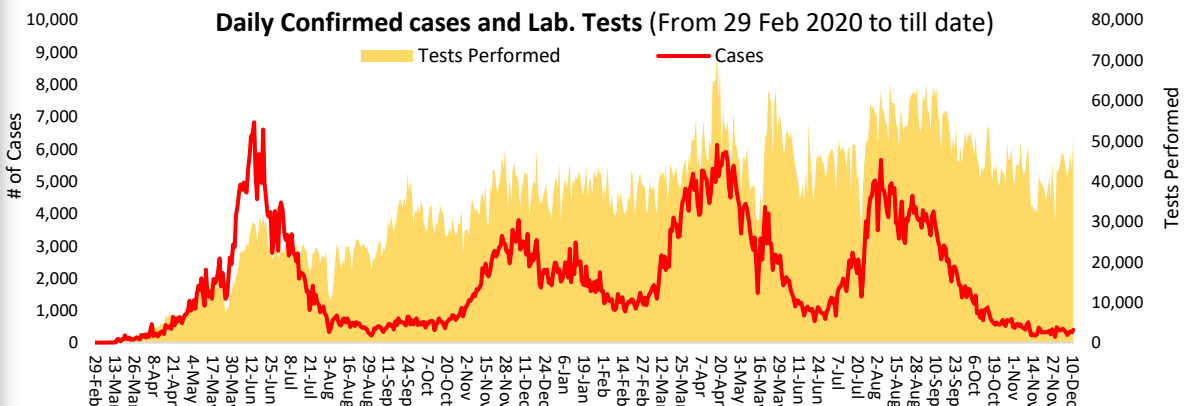

On 7th December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired the inaugural session of the International Symposium on Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR). The Symposium was organized by Faculty of Veterinary Sciences, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad (UAF). UAF Pro Vice Chancellor Prof Dr Anas Sarwar Qureshi welcomed the WR. Director, Institute of Microbiology Prof. Dr Sajjad-ur-Rehman, and Advisor UN antimicrobial resistance committee Prof. Timothy R Walsh also attended the event.

In his speech, Dr Palitha underscored that antimicrobial resistance is a global health and development threat, requiring urgent action to achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). He stated that WHO has launched the Global Antimicrobial Resistance and Use Surveillance System (GLASS) in 2015 to continue filling the knowledge gaps and informed strategies at all levels. He said that WHO had also prepared a Global Patient Safety Action Plan, which provides guidelines and safety measures to reduce practices that lead to harms to patients.
