

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported 548 new cases of COVID-19 on 10 September 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 300,371 with 6,370 deaths (CFR: 2.12%). Out of the total 5,795 currently active cases, 1,021 cases are hospitalized, out of which **535** (**52.39%**) are in critical condition. **4,774** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of 288,206 (95.95%) cases have recovered and discharged.









COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR





FLOOD SITUATION

Friday, 11th September 2020

According to National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) no new incidence of heavy rains and floods was reported in any part of the country during 9th to 10th September 2020.

To date total **301 deaths**, and **233** Injuries have been reported. Over **12,676** people who were stuck due to floods were evacuated to safer places by armed forces and district administration rescue teams. Over, **78,469 houses fully** and **138,147 partially** damaged since 15th June. See the table below for details.


The government of Sindh has created **196** relief camps in different parts of province. Currently **23,629** persons are residing in these camps.


