

MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 8th March 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Health and Population Welfare Department South Punjab and Pakistan Kidney & Liver Institute (KPLI) and Research Center Lahore started a six-days certificate course on Infection Prevention & Control (IPC) in Lahore. Director General Health Services Punjab, Dr Haroon Jahangir Khan and Head of Infection Prevention and Control, Microbiology department, PKLI Dr Altaf Ahmad inaugurated the course. The purpose of the course is to train IPC committee members on implementation of IPC in health care setting.

A total of 23 participants comprising of Assistant Medical Superintendents, IPC Medical Officers and the In-charge Nurses from 8 secondary and Tertiary Care hospital of 5 districts in South Punjab are attending the training. Course methodology includes theory and practical components of IPC. After the course the participants will assess the IPC practices in their respective hospitals, develop and implement IPC improvement plan that will be evaluated by an independent monitoring team after one month. Dr Haroon appreciated WHO support for conducting the IPC certificate course for South Punjab.
