

On 12th July 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and the Special Assistant to Prime Minster (SAPM) on Health, Dr Faisal Sultan, jointly launched the digital Web-based Monitoring and Reporting System for Sustainable Development Goal (SDG)-3 and other Health related goals at the MoNHSR&C headquarters, Islamabad. This system is open for public information and it is envisaged to promote information use and tracking of progress.
