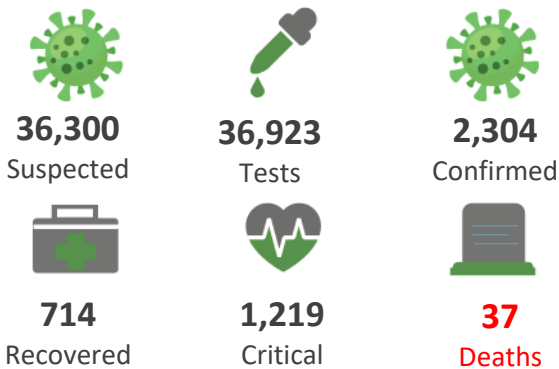


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



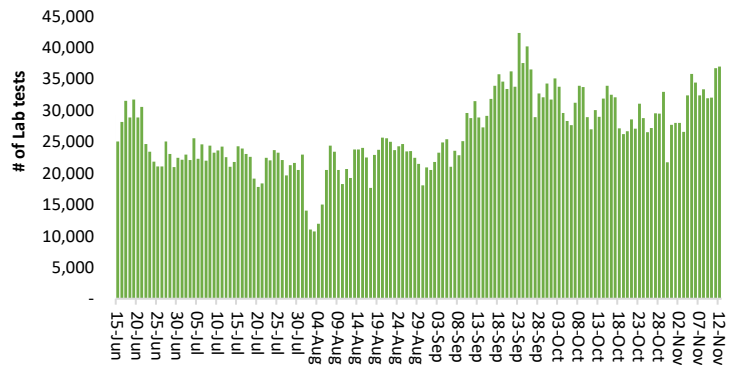
Pakistan reported **2,304** new cases of COVID-19 on **12 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **352,296** with **7,055** deaths (**CFR: 2.00%**). Out of the total **23,641** currently active cases, **1,405** cases are hospitalized.

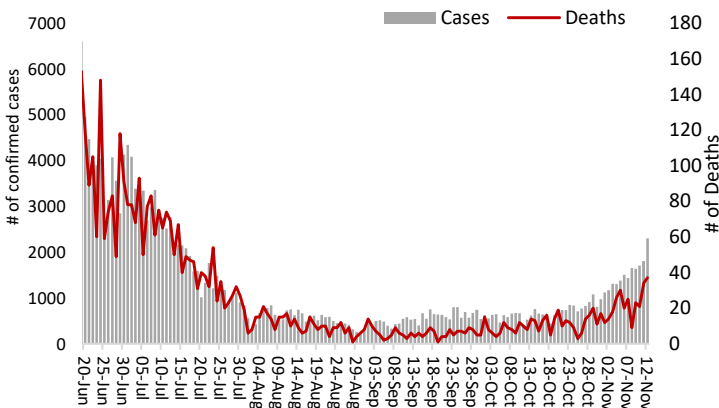

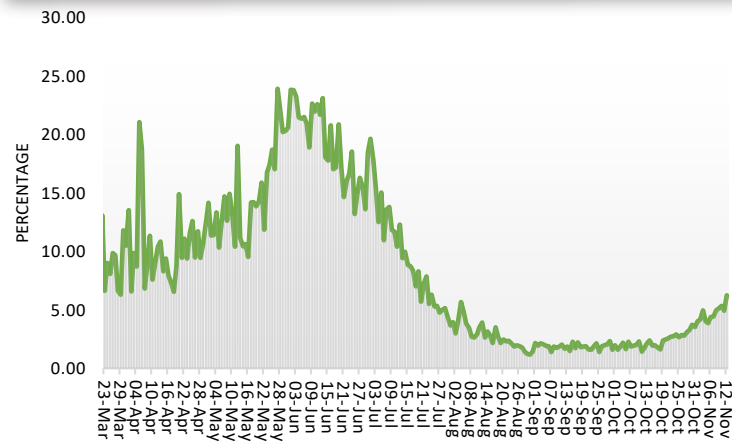


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

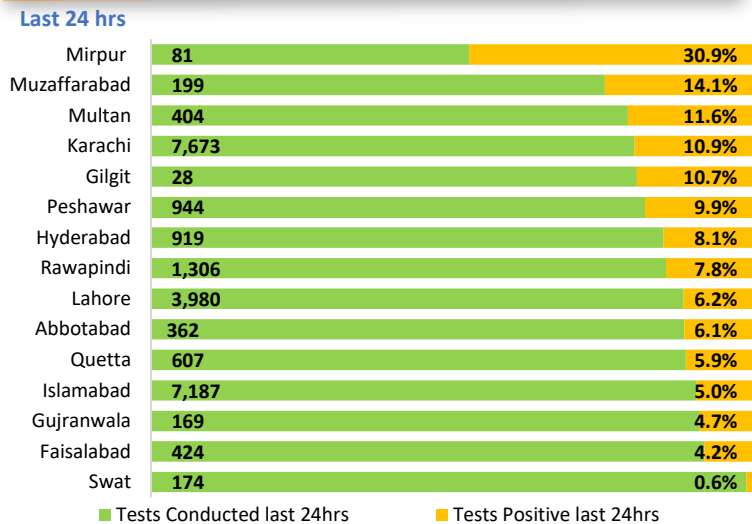
