WHE Team lead Dr Michael Lukwiya briefed the participants on current Dengue situation in the country and, Ms. Oleksandra from UNHCR presented Refugee Response Plan for 2021. The participants agreed on updating and maintaining

the 5W matrix and holding regular monthly meeting. WHO Pakistan WR, Dr Palitha thanked the health partners for their active participation in the meeting. He requested them to continue supporting the Government of Pakistan.
