

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported 526 new cases of COVID-19 on 12 September 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 301,481 with 6,379 deaths (CFR: 2.11%). Out of the total 5,673 currently active cases, 1,000 cases are hospitalized, out of which **534** (**53.4%**) are in critical condition. **4,673** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of 289,429 (96%) have recovered and discharged.





Daily Incidence by Province





COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR






