

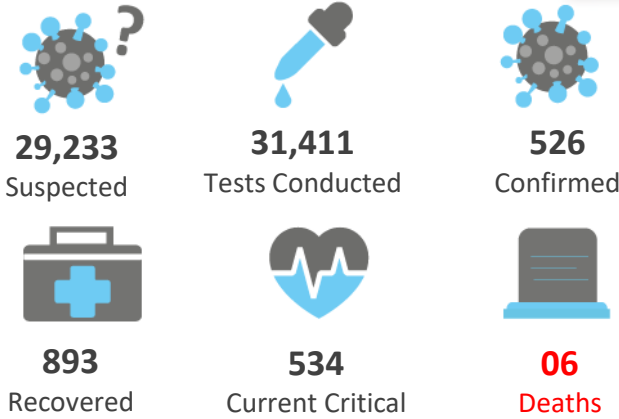

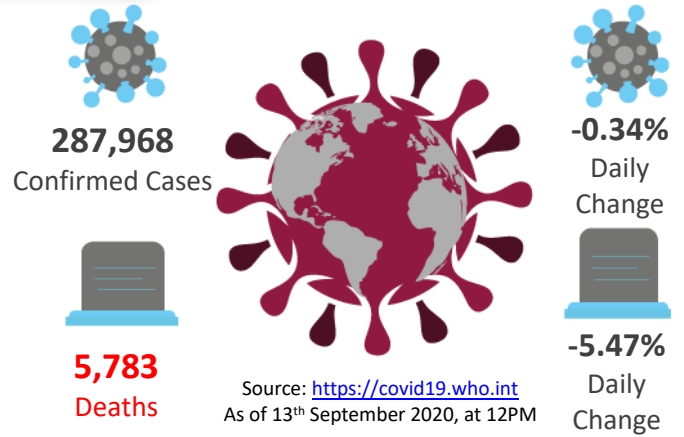

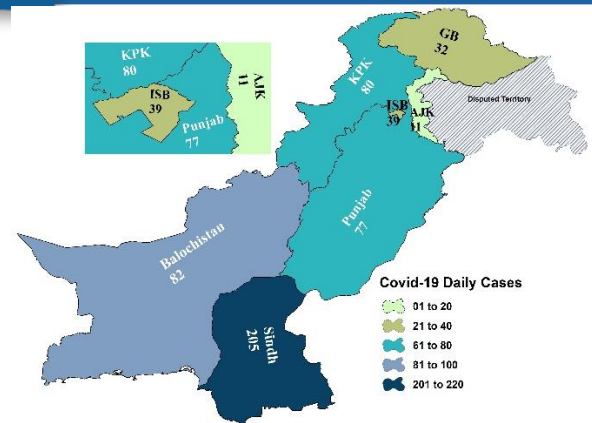

Executive Summary

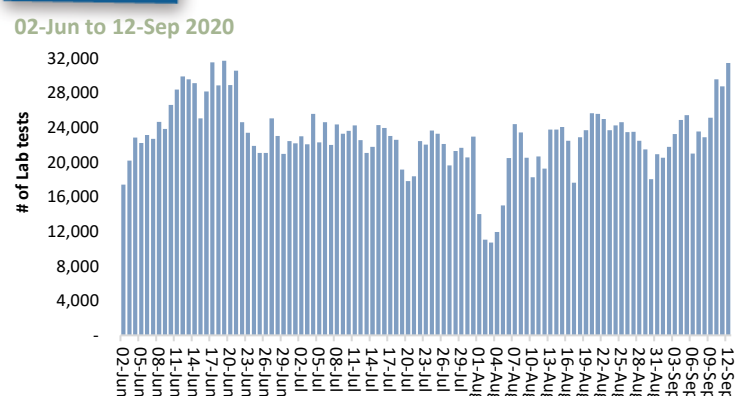
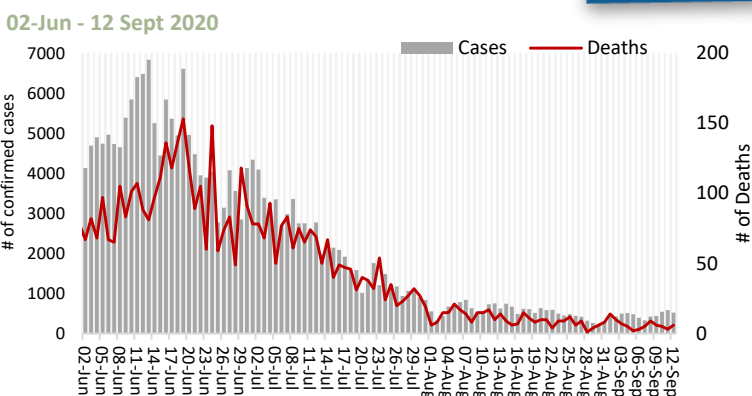
Daily Incidence by Province

Pakistan reported **526** new cases of COVID-19 on **12 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **301,481** with **6,379** deaths (**CFR: 2.11%**). Out of the total **5,673** currently active cases, **1,000** cases are hospitalized, out of which **534 (53.4%)** are in critical condition. **4,673** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **289,429 (96%)** have recovered and discharged.

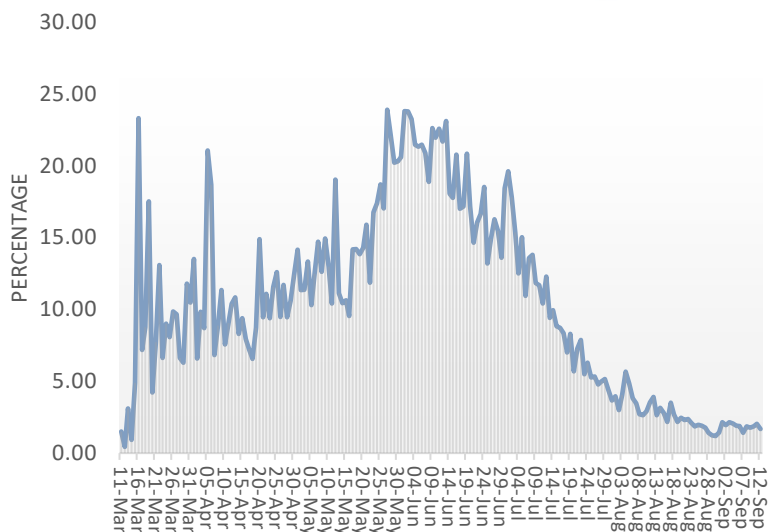

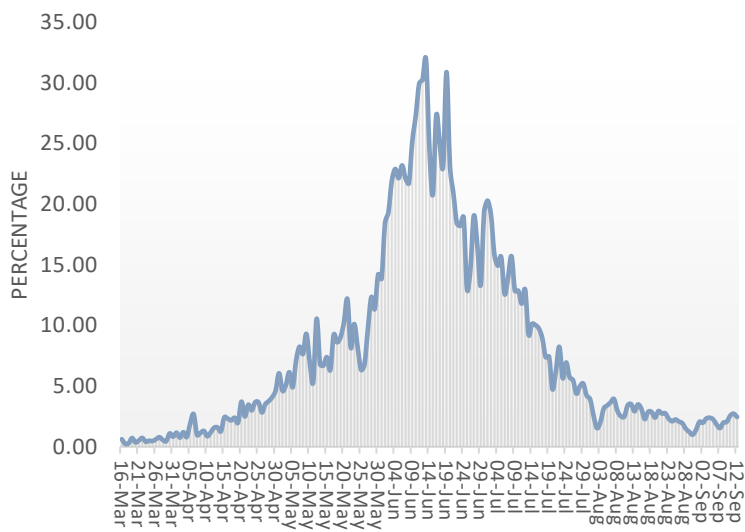

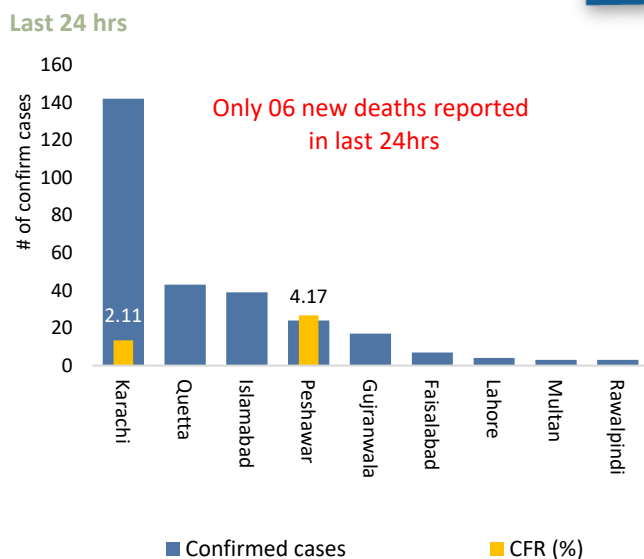
Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate



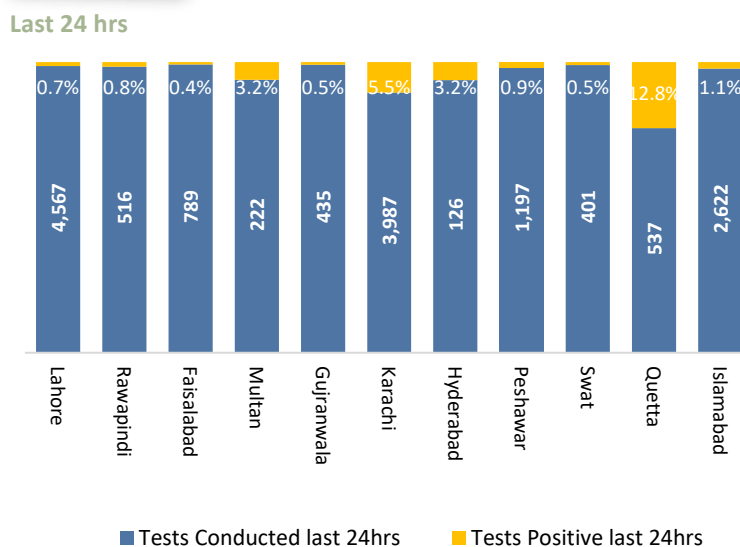
Daily COVID-19 Attack rate Per million population

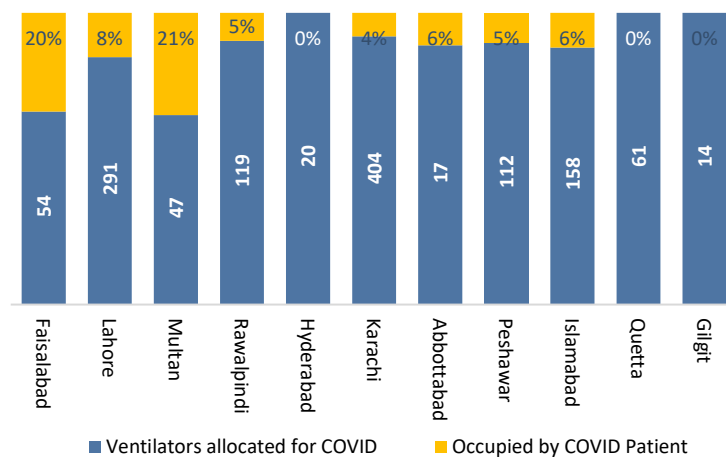

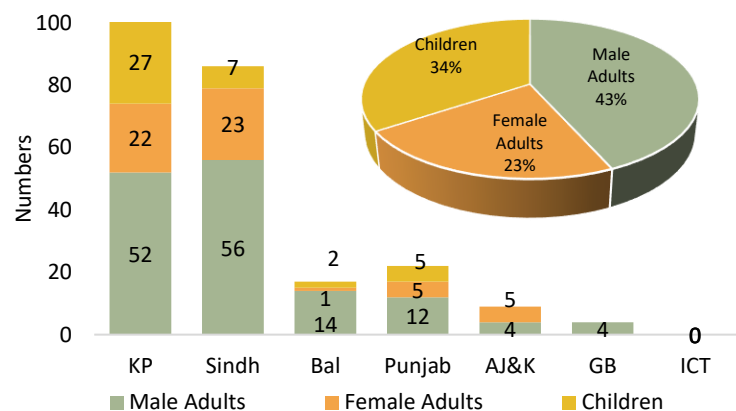

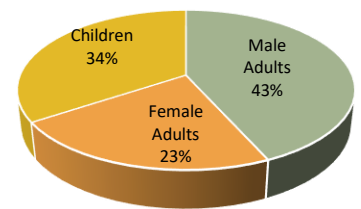
