



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



Pakistan reported **3,097** new cases of COVID-19 on **13** January **2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **511,921** with **10,818** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%).** Out of the total **33,869** currently active cases **2,903** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 13th January 2021, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr. Palitha Mahipala, visited the Polio high-risk UCs in Baldia and Keamari Towns, district West Karachi. The purpose of the visit was to monitor implementation of the Polio National Immunization Days (NIDs) campaign.

During the visit, Dr Palitha met with the mobile teams and discussed the challenges faced by the teams in the field and assured the Polio teams of WHO continuous support. In addition, the WR met with District Health Officer of West Karachi, Dr Hafiz Abro and Additional District Health Officer, Dr Atiq. During the meeting the WR discussed Current COVID-19 situation and emphasized on importance of improving Lab testing in the context of Trace, Test and Quarantine strategy. WR also held a meeting with the Deputy Commissioner and Additional Deputy Commissioner District West Karachi regarding NIDs campaign in the district.
