Summary Table by Province

On 13th December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala and the Ambassador of Republic of Korea H.E Suh Sangpyo signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) worth 500,000 USD. The signing ceremony took place at the Embassy of Republic of Korea in Islamabad. The MoU is for a project to enhance disease surveillance and Afghan refugees' access to vaccines. The project will be implemented over 12 months.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha thanked the Government and People of the Republic of Korea for their support towards Afghan refugees response in Pakistan. He noted that the funding will go a long way in strengthening disease surveillance and access to COVID-19 vaccines among the refugees. H.E Suh appreciated WHO's ongoing support to the refugees. The two officials pledged their commitment to further enhance the collaboration in support of government of Pakistan intervention.
