

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **539** new cases of COVID-19 on **13 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **302,020** with **6,383** deaths **(CFR: 2.11%)**. Out of the total **5,831** currently active cases, **1,011** cases are hospitalized, out of which **551 (54.50%)** are in critical condition. **4,820** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **289,806 (95.95%)** have recovered and discharged.








Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate


Maintaining Essential Health Services


Daily COVID-19 Attack rate

Per million population




COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR
