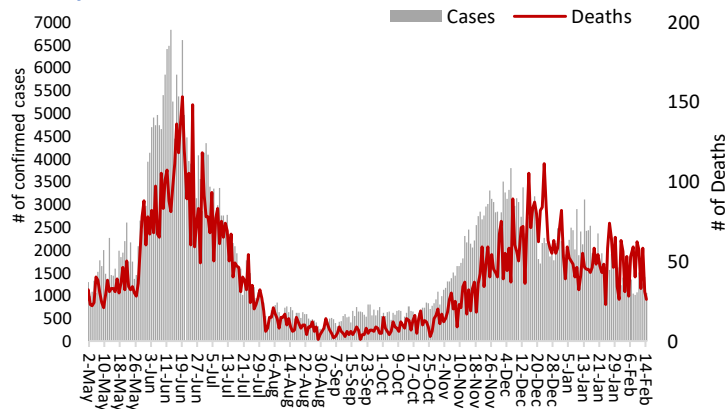

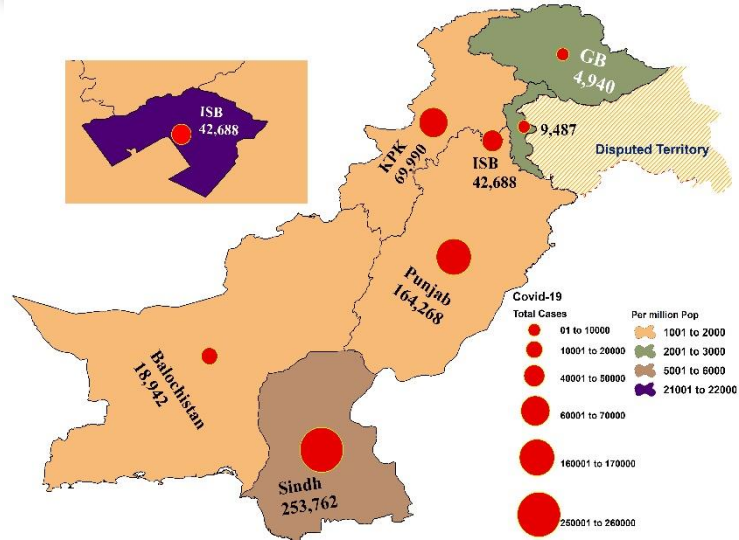


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

02-May 2020 - 14-Feb 2021



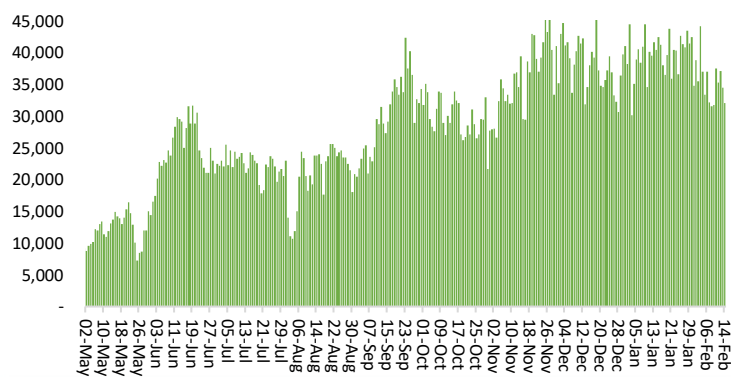
### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



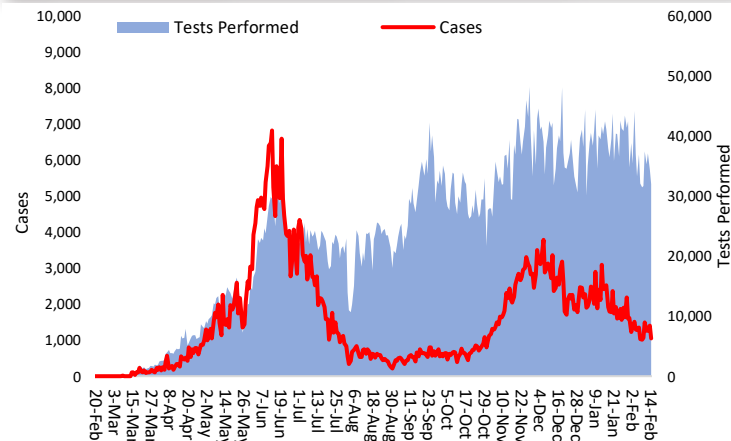
Pakistan reported **1,048** new cases of COVID-19 on **14<sup>th</sup> February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **564,077** with **12,333** deaths (**CFR: 2.19%**). Out of the total **25,747** currently active cases **2,115** cases are hospitalized.

## MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with the Provincial health department Sindh conducted orientation session on SARI/ILI sentinel surveillance for the District Health Management Team in Hyderabad division. Director General Health Sindh, Dr Irshad Ahmad Memon and Head of WHO sub-office Sindh, Dr Sara Salman, Co-chaired the meeting. The objective of the meeting was to advocate for strengthening the SARI/ILI sentinel surveillance and implementation of IDSR.

All District Health Officers (DHOs) and district Focal Persons for the COVID-19, SARI/ILI Sentinel surveillance from the 9 districts and 3 PEI District Surveillance Officers of the Hyderabad Division attended the meeting. The current gaps in SARI / ILI cases detection and referral for lab testing in the districts and the way forward was reviewed with the DHOs. Dr Irshad Ahmed DG Health Sindh directed all the DHOs to focus on the data quality, strengthening of SARI/ILI sentinel sites surveillance and ensure all the sentinel site focal persons are notified in all the districts.
