

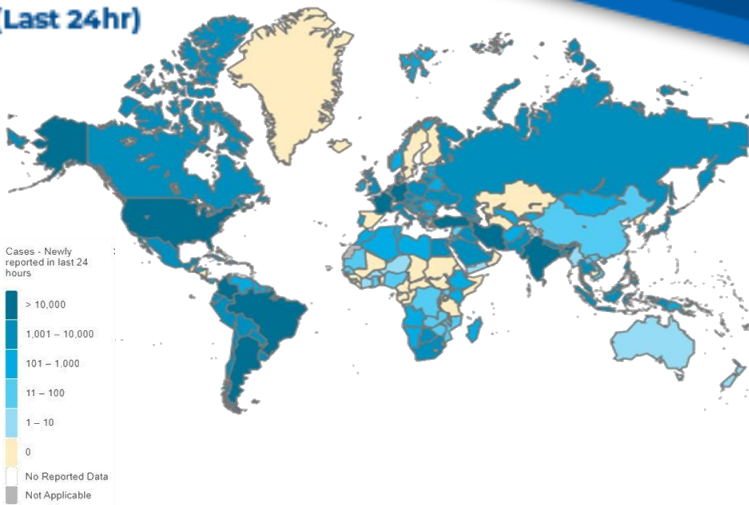

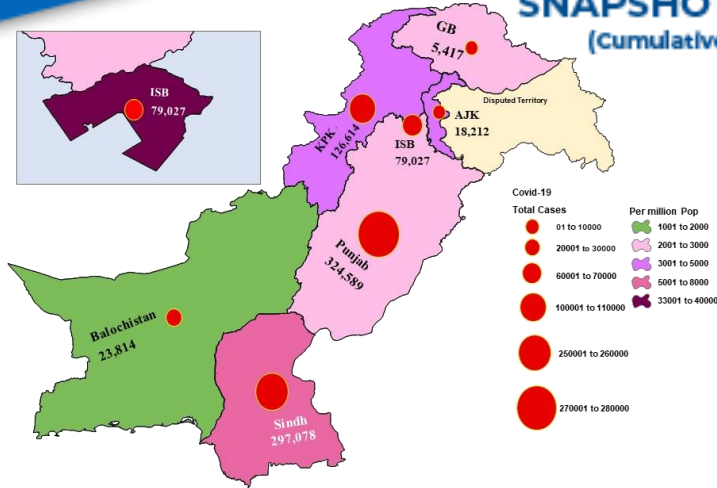

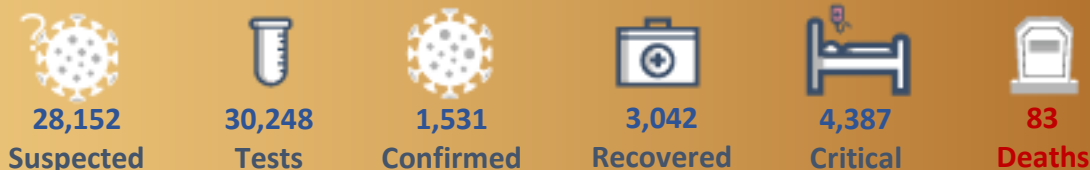

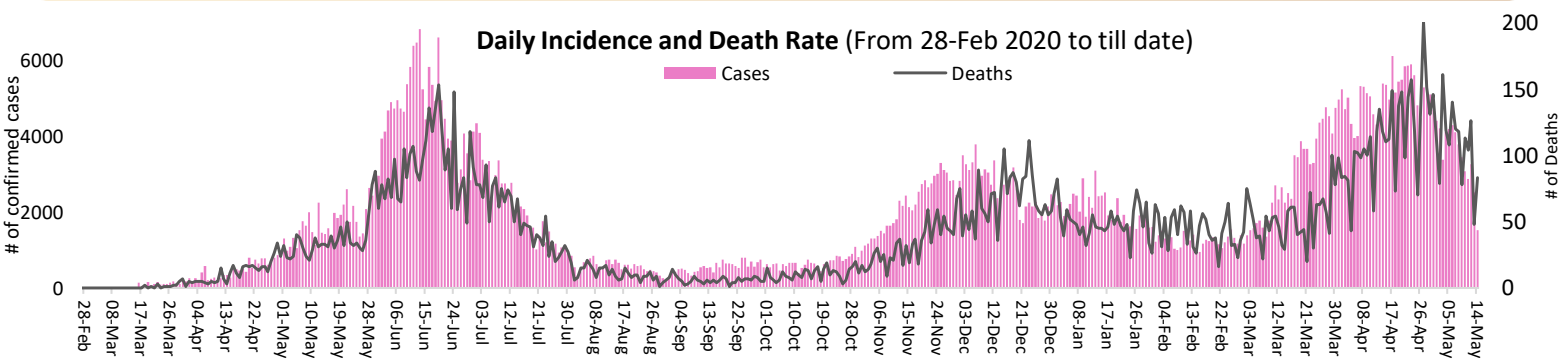
## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



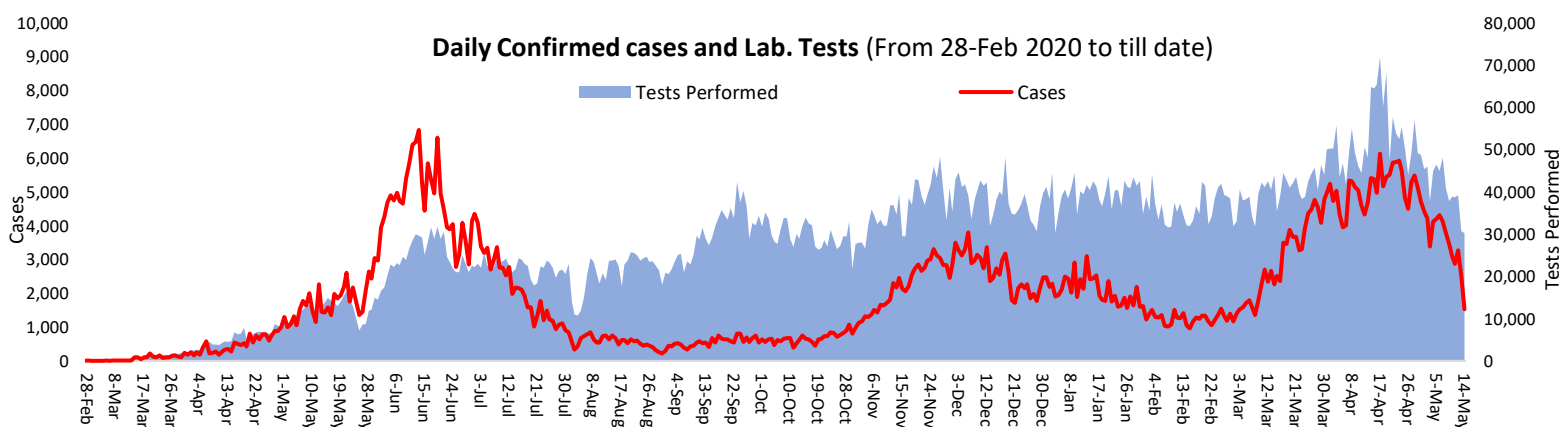
## PAKISTAN SNAPSHOT (LAST 24hr)

## Meeting and Coordination



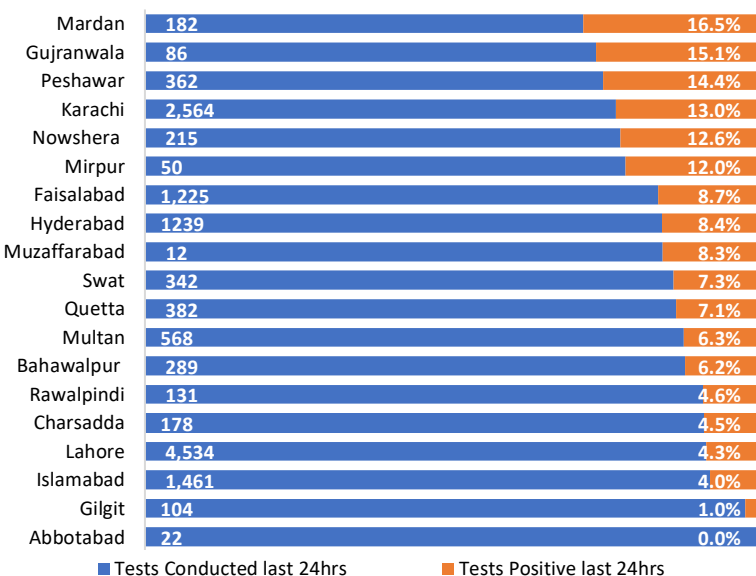
On the 14<sup>th</sup> May 2021, The Honorable Chief Secretary, Balochistan, Mr Mathar Niaz Rana convened an emergency meeting at the Balochistan secretariate office to discuss the current trend of COVID 19 cases in the province and review the response plan, with a view of enhancing the vaccination coverage in the province.

The meeting was attended by the WHO Surveillance Officer, Balochistan, Dr Dawood Riaz, The Provincial Secretary Health, Balochistan, Mr Noor ul Haq Baloch, EPI coordinator Dr Ishaq Panezai, Cell incharge Dr Mustafa, DOH Dr Sarmad among other.

The meetings resolved to establish additional vaccination centers at district hospital level and called upon the deputy commissioners to provide additional support to this cause. the Chief Secretary acknowledged WHO Pakistan support to the COVID-19 response.
