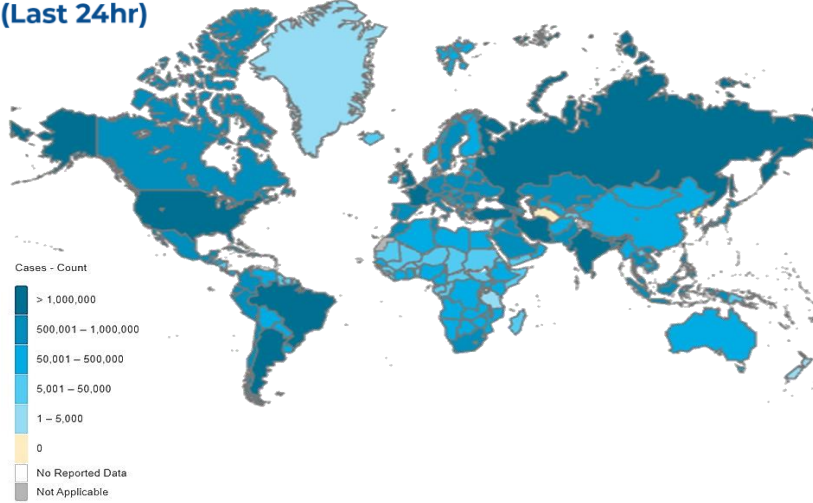
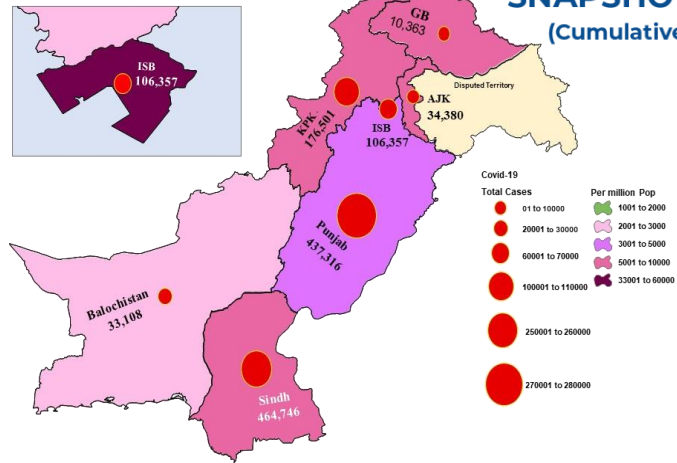

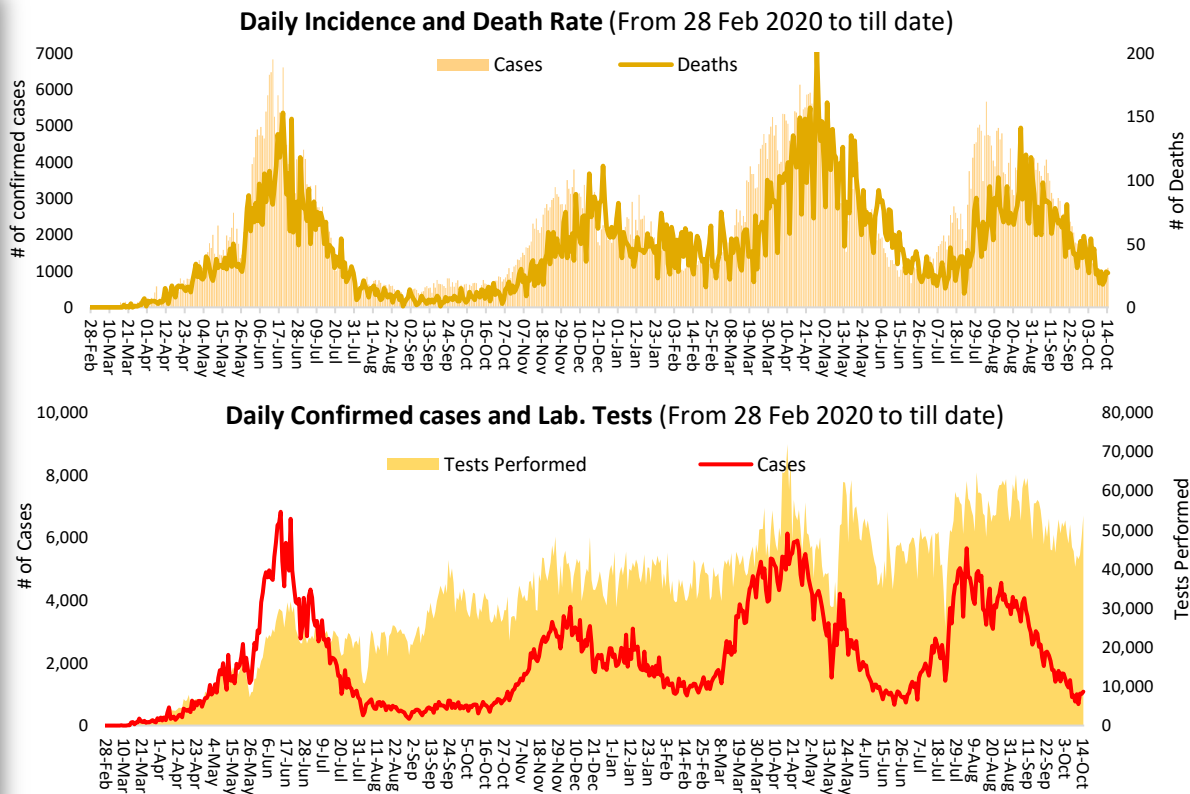

## Meetings & Coordination



On 14<sup>th</sup> October 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met with all the District Health Officers of Karachi namely: DHO West, Dr Razak Tunio; DHO East, Dr Jameel Shaikh; ADHO South, Dr Ashiq Shah; ADHO Central, Dr Sanaullah Soomro and ADHO Korangi, Dr Abdul Laiq. The meeting was also attended by the Focal Person EPI Malir, Dr Ahsan Memon and the head of WHO Sub Office Sindh, Dr Sara Salman.

The objective of the meeting was to discuss strengthening of COVID-19 vaccination and routine immunization in Karachi. During the meeting, Dr Palitha appreciated the Government of Sindh for the progress in the COVID 19 response especially vaccination roll out during the period of crises. He pledged continued support from WHO. The WR emphasized on the need to enhance implementation of public health measures: social distancing, hand hygiene, and cough etiquette. The DHO appreciated WHO for the continuing support.

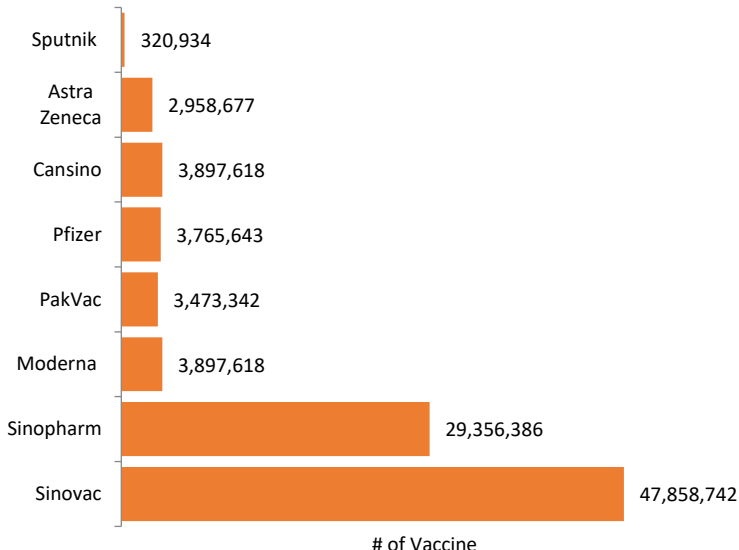
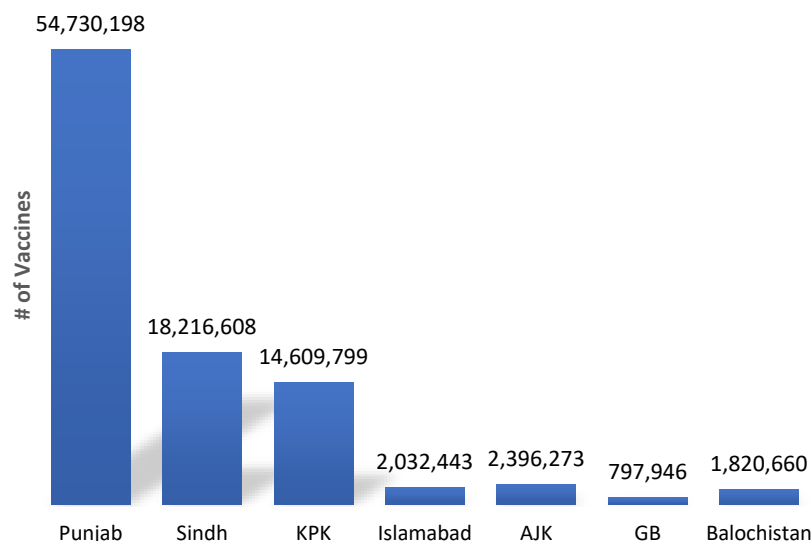
