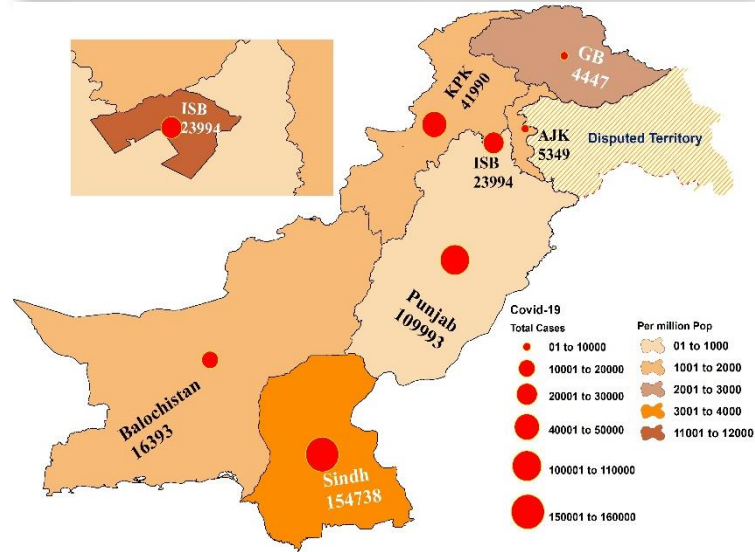

### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE



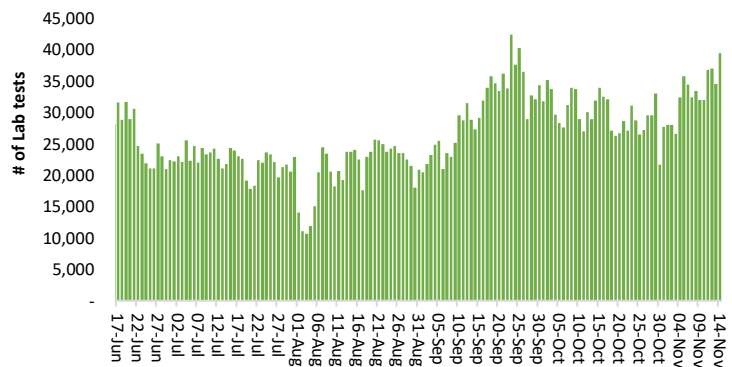
### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



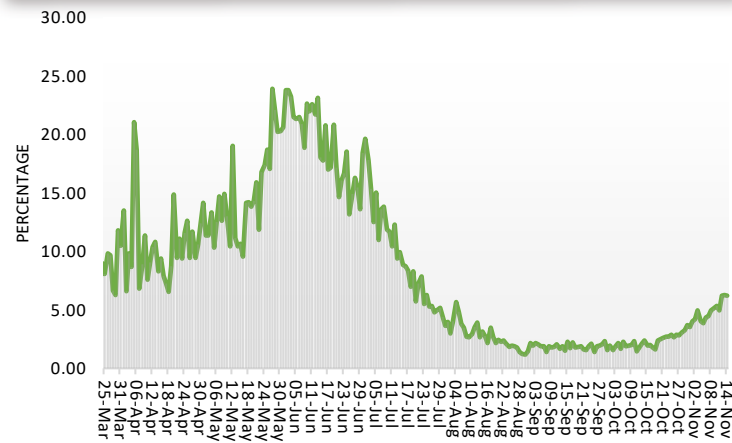
Pakistan reported **2,443** new cases of COVID-19 on **14 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **356,904** with **7,141** deaths (**CFR: 2.00%**). Out of the total **26,538** currently active cases, **1,569** cases are hospitalized.

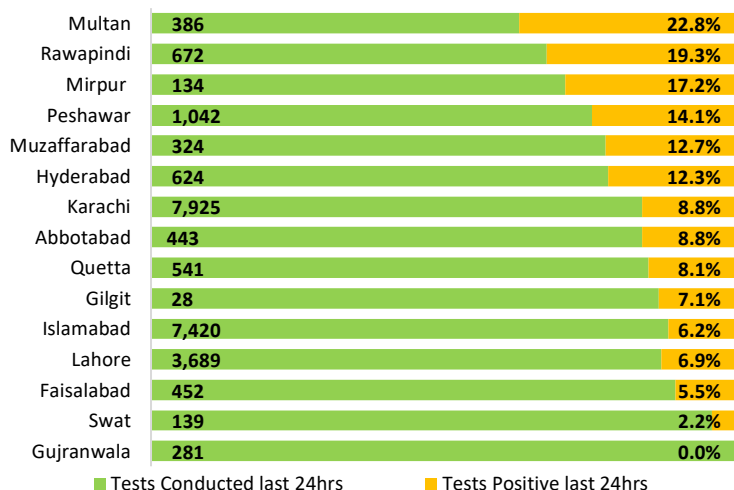
## MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> November 2020, WHO Country office Pakistan conducted virtual partner briefing. The briefing was chaired by the WHO Country representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala. The WR briefed partners on the current COVID-19 situation and the Government's strategy to control the spread of COVID-19.

Dr Palitha explicitly underscored the need to continue supporting the government of Pakistan in responding to COVID-19 especially in maintaining the essential health services. He further stated that there is need for all partners supporting the government to have a unified message for preventive measures and prompt implementation of risk communication and community engagement plan.
