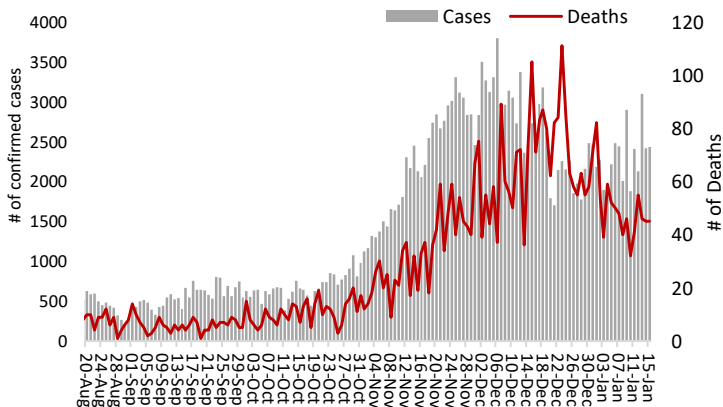

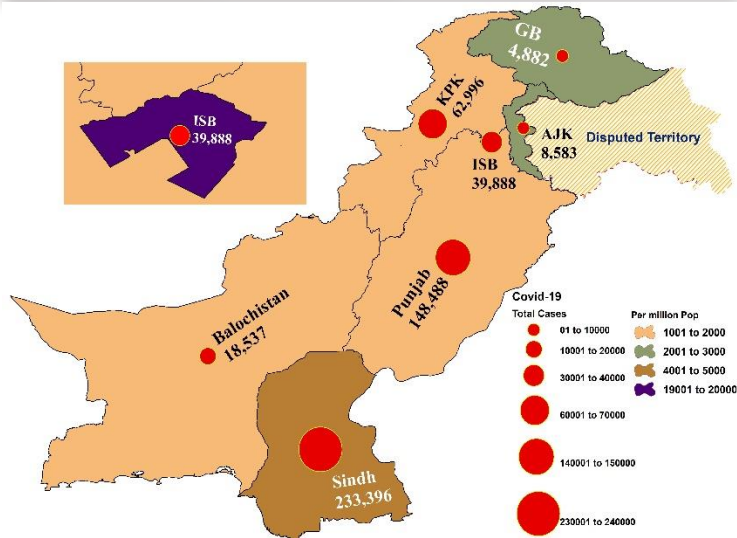


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

20-Aug 2020 - 15-Jan 2021



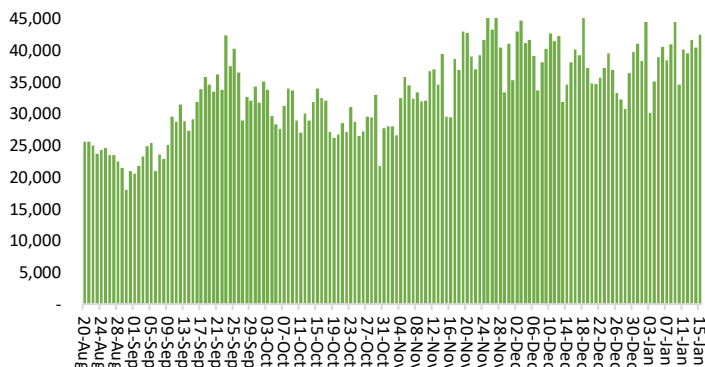
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



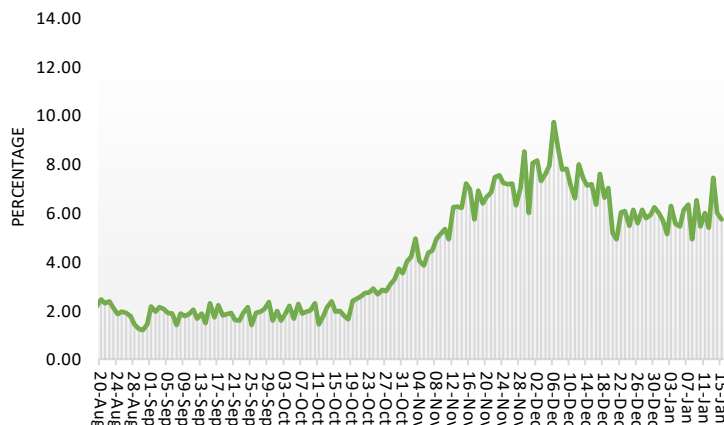
Pakistan reported **2,432** new cases of COVID-19 on **15 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **516,770** with **10,908** deaths (**CFR: 2.11%**). Out of the total **33,763** currently active cases **2,840** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

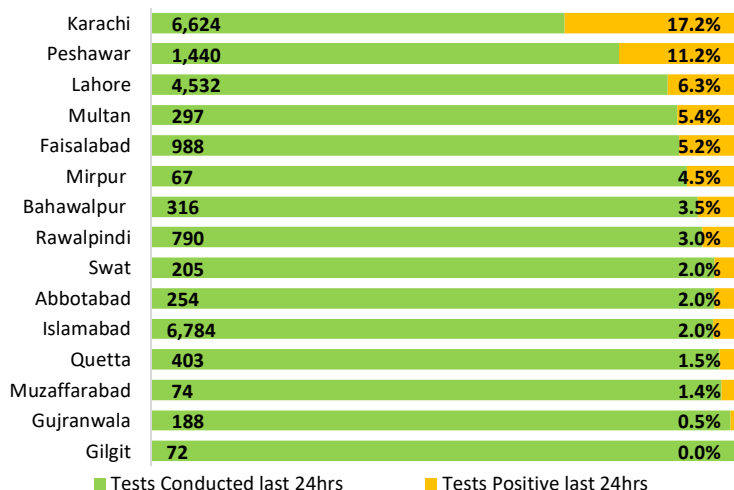
On 15th January 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr. Palitha Mahipala handed over assortment of IT equipment and other supplies to the Chief Executive Officer Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP) Mr. Asim Rauf. The supplies included desktops, scanners, printer, laptops (2), face masks KN 94, hand sanitizers and automatic sensor hand dispenser machines. The support will enable DRAP to link Pakistan Integrated Regulatory Information System (PIRIMS) software with Pharmacovigilance of COVID-19 management, vaccines and reporting of clinical trials.

During his speech, the WR pledged to continue supporting DRAP in ensuring efficacy, quality and safety of medicines and other supplies for routine and emergency preparedness and response to epidemics and pandemics in Pakistan.
