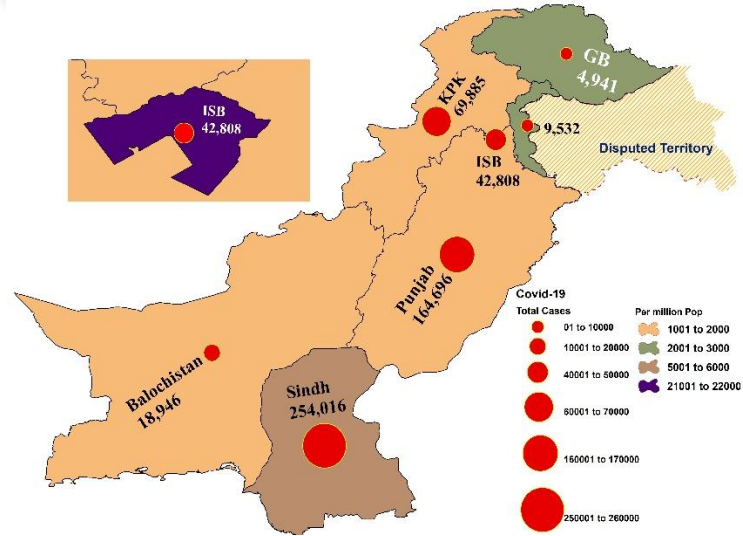


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

03-May 2020 - 14-Feb 2021



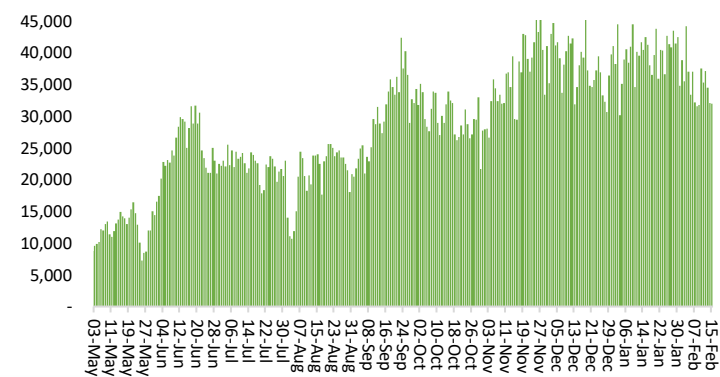
### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



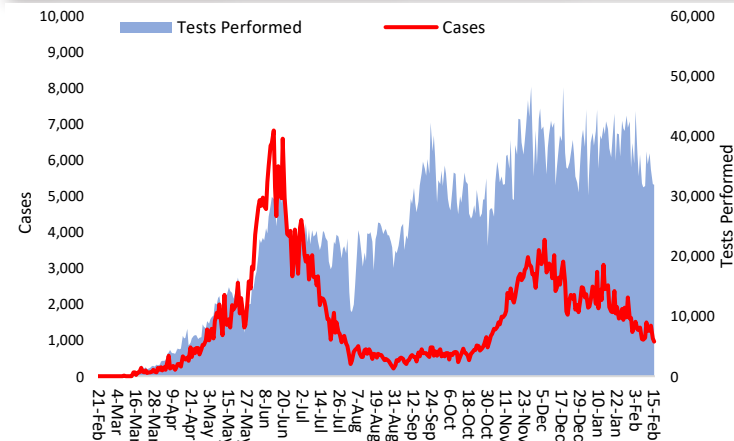
Pakistan reported **958** new cases of COVID-19 on **15<sup>th</sup> February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **564,824** with **12,380** deaths (**CFR: 2.19%**). Out of the total **25,383** currently active cases **2,101** cases are hospitalized.

## MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial Health Department Punjab conducted the 3<sup>rd</sup> orientation Session for health care providers on SARI/ILI Sentinel surveillance. The objective of the orientation was to strengthen early detection of COVID-19 cases through the SARI/ILI sentinel surveillance sites in Sialkot district. The Chief Executive Officer Health Sialkot, Dr Aslam Chaudhary chaired the session. The participants were also informed about the registration of frontline health care workers for the COVID-19 vaccination. The session had a total of 20 participants as detailed below: four medical officers, sixteen Nurses and Paramedical staff.

The CEO Health, Dr Aslam Chaudhary expressed his gratitude to WHO Pakistan for its continued support to Pakistan for COVID-19 Pandemic response.
