



#### **Summary Table by Province**

On 15<sup>th</sup> September 2021, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met the Secretary Primary & Secondary Healthcare Department Mr Imran Sikandar Baloch during his support supervisory visit to Punjab Province from 14<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> September 2021. The WR donated a PCR machine and Biosafety Cabinet to support COVID-19 testing in Punjab. The handover ceremony was witnessed by among others; the Secretary Technical, Primary and Secondary Healthcare department, Dr Asif Altaf, In-charge Provincial Reference Lab Punjab, Dr Hasnain Javed and Head of WHO Sub Office Punjab, Dr Jamshaid Ahmed. This is the 6th PCR machine that WHO Pakistan has donated to Government of Punjab.

In his remarks, The WR encouraged the Government of Punjab to enhance COVID-19 testing across the Province and pledged WHO support towards this effort. Mr Imran Sikandar expressed gratitude to WHO for the donation and commitment to strengthen COVID-19 testing.
