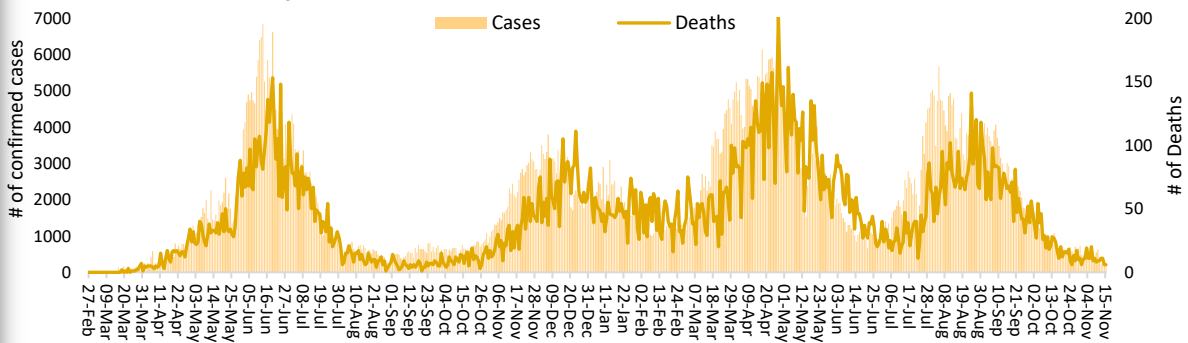

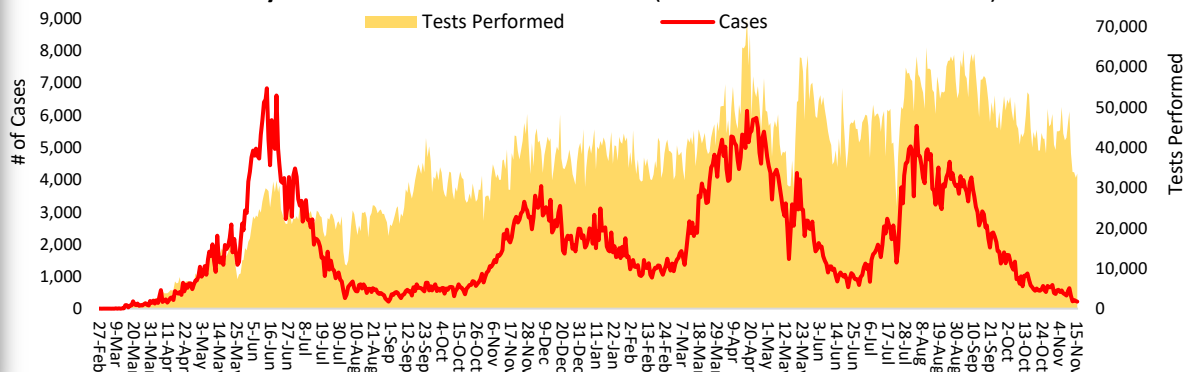

On 11th November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala held a meeting with Senior Advisor for Health Systems and Policy Research, Planning Commission, Dr Shabnam Sarfraz. The meeting discussed Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR) Strategic Plan and National Action Plan that is being developed by MoNHSR&C with technical support from WHO. Team Lead WHE Dr Michael Lukwiya and WHE team members attended the meeting.

During the meeting, Dr Palitha appreciated the Government of Pakistan specifically, the Planning Commission and MoNHSR&C for their commitment in implementation of IDSR. The WR reaffirmed WHO's continuous support towards strengthening of surveillance systems in the country. Dr Shabnam appreciated WHO support in epidemic preparedness and response. She emphasized on the need for enhanced coordination and multisectoral collaboration in disease prevention and control.
