




#### **Executive Summary**

Pakistan reported 641 new cases of COVID-19 on 16 October 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 322,452 with 6,638 deaths (CFR: 2.06%). Out of the total 9,174 currently active cases, 833 cases are hospitalized, out of which 567 (68.07%) are in critical condition. 8,341 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of 306,640 (95.10%) have recovered and discharged.


#### **Daily Incidence/Mortality**



### **Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate**






### Daily Incidence by Province




#### **COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province** (Last 24hrs)

#### **Meetings & Coordination**

A joint mission of WHO Country Office Pakistan and Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination (NHSR&C) visited Quetta, Balochistan from 15-16 October 2020, to assess the Children Hospital Quetta for upgradation of a Nutrition Stabilisation Centre and establishment of Nutrition Training Center.

The mission also visited the Sandeman Provincial Hospital at the request of the Provincial Nutrition Directorate as a potential site to establish a Nutrition Stabilization Center.

The mission met the Parliamentary Secretary Health Balochistan, Dr. Rubaba Buledi, and briefed him on WHO's ongoing support and future plans to mitigate health system challenges impeding sustained delivery of quality lifesaving nutrition services through the Nutrition Stabilization Centers.
