

Executive Summary


Pakistan reported 545 new cases of COVID-19 on 16 **September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 303,634 with 6,399 deaths (CFR: 2.11%). Out of the total 6,066 currently active cases, 998 cases are hospitalized, out of which 593 (59.41%) are in critical condition. 5,068 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of 291,169 (95.89%) have recovered and discharged.





Daily Incidence by Province





Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate




Maintaining Essential Health Services



Trends of COVID-19 confirmed cases








COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR

by Major Cities / Districts




Occupied COVID-19 ventilators
