





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE






TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.

Pakistan reported 1,272 new cases of COVID-19 on 17th February 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 567,261 with 12,488 deaths (CFR: 2.20%). Out of the total 24,176 currently active cases 2,111 cases are hospitalized.
