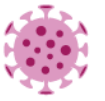

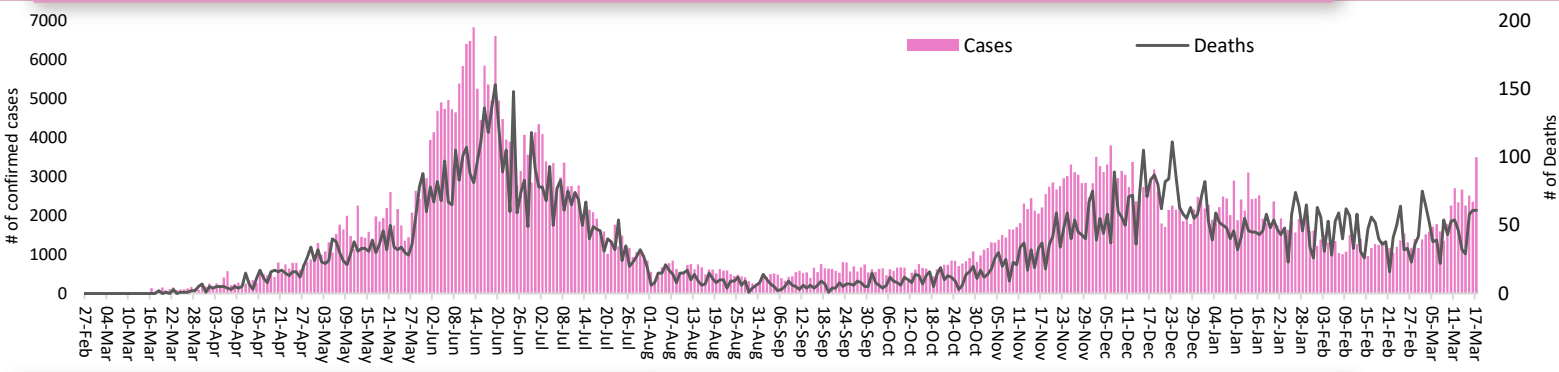

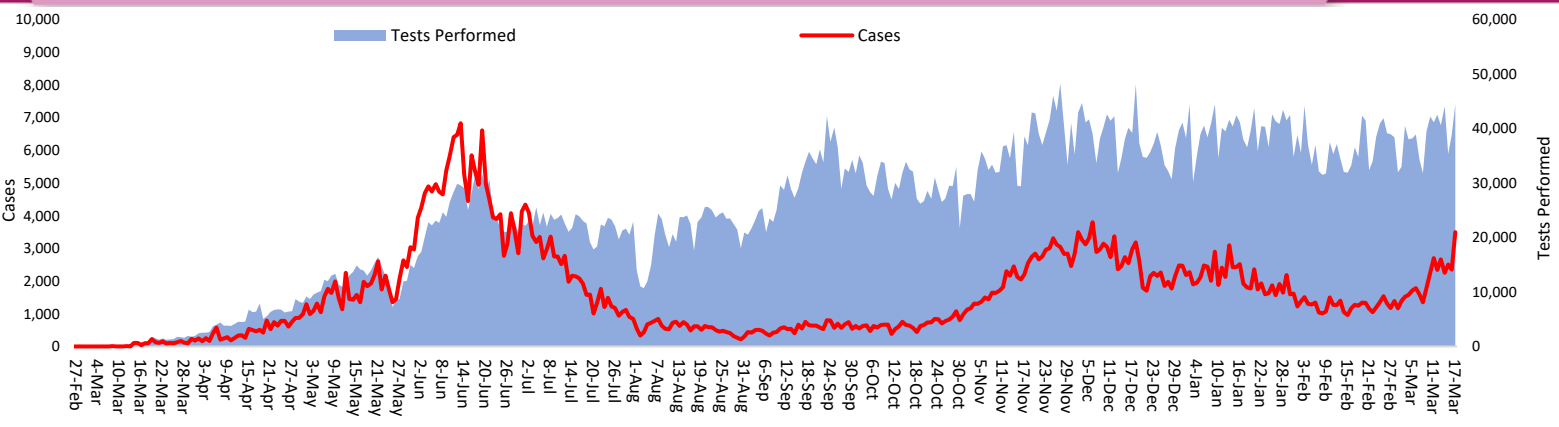

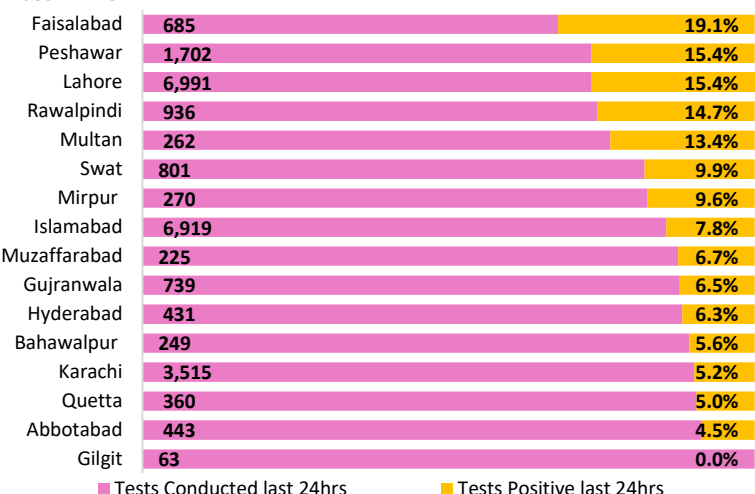
Mr Ophoff Peter appreciated the efforts of WHO Pakistan for its continued support to the government of Pakistan for COVID-19 Pandemic response.
