





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,208** new cases of COVID-19 on **17 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **363,380** with **7,230** deaths **(CFR: 1.99%).** Out of the total **30,362** currently active cases, **1,769** cases are hospitalized.
