








World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with the Provincial Health Department Sindh conducted a three-day Training of Trainers on Early Essential Newborn Care (EENC) at Shaikh Zaid Women Hospital Larkana from 15-17 November 2021. The opening ceremony was officiated by the Medical Superintendent Chandka Medical College Hospital Larkana, Dr Abdul Sattar Shaikh. The Registrar, Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical University Larkana Dr Syed Kararo Shah participated in the Closing ceremony and handed over certificates to the 25 participants drawn from 12 districts.

During his opening remarks, Dr Abdul Sattar expressed his gratitude to WHO for providing support for the training.

During the closing ceremony Dr Syed Kararo Shah emphasized to the participants to plan for the rollout of EENC to maintain the quality of implementation of the protocols.
