





TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,972** new cases of COVID-19 on **17 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **451,494** with **9,164** deaths **(CFR: 2.02%)**. Total **2,988** cases are hospitalised out of **42,478** currently active cases.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Today, 18th December 2020, WHO Country office Pakistan conducted a virtual partner briefing meeting. WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired the meeting. The WR briefed partners on the current COVID-19 situation globally, in the Eastern Mediterranean Region and in Pakistan. He discussed the Government's strategy and response to control the spread of COVID-19 in the country.
