



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



Pakistan reported **1,800** new cases of COVID-19 on **18** January **2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **523,011** with **11,055** deaths (CFR: **2.11%**). Out of the total **35,485** currently active cases **2,840** cases are hospitalized.
