



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,245** new cases of COVID-19 on **18**th **February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **568,506** with **12,527** deaths **(CFR: 2.20%)**. Out of the total **24,139** currently active cases **2,070** cases are hospitalized.
