







INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,547** new cases of COVID-19 on **18** November **2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **365,927** with **7,248** deaths (CFR: **1.98%**). Out of the total **32,005** currently active cases, **2,025** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Today 19th November 2020, the Special Assistant to the Prime Minister for National Health Services, Regulation & Coordination H.E Dr Faisal Sultan participated in a WHO/EMRO Regional virtual press briefings on COVID-19 response in three countries. The WHO Country Representative for Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala was also present for the briefing.

During the briefing, the Special assistant to the Prime Minister on NHSR&C shared experience of Pakistan in controlling the first wave of COVID-19 in the country. In his remarks, the minister appreciated frequent EMRO mission to Pakistan. He stated that those mission provided the needed support for controlling the COVID-19 epidemic in Pakistan.
