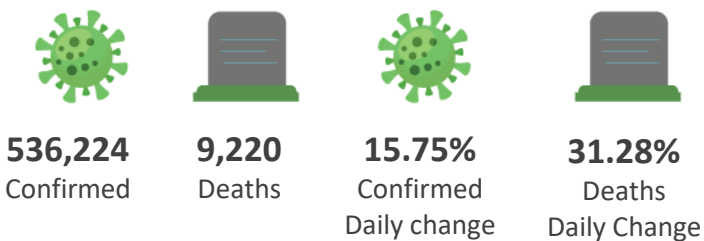


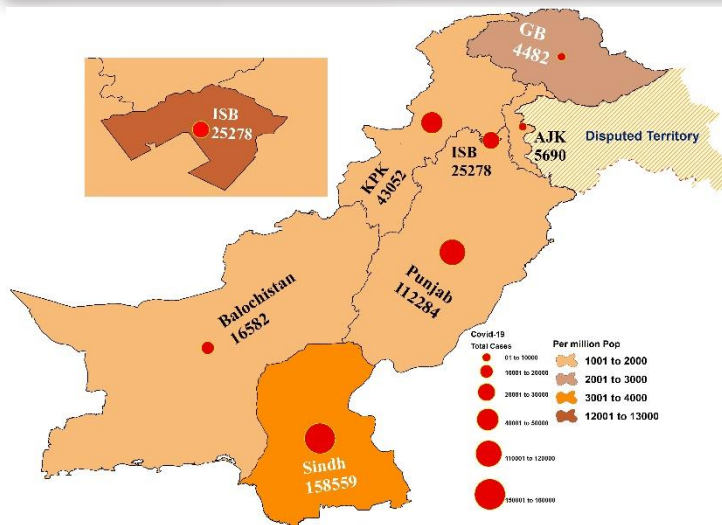

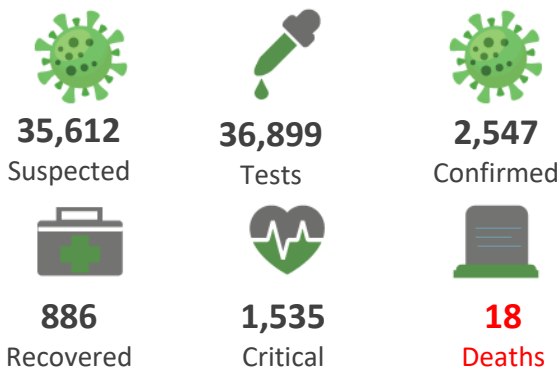


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



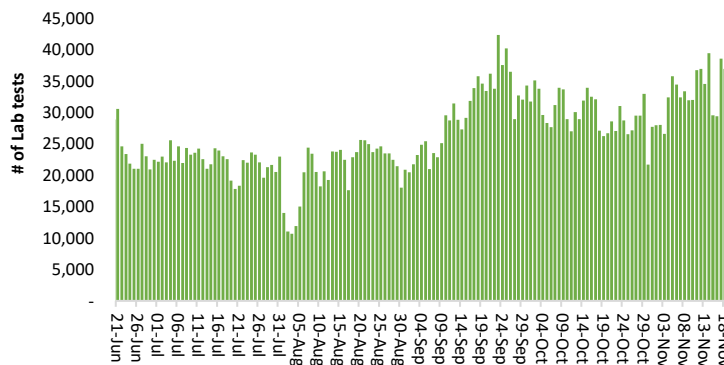
Pakistan reported **2,547** new cases of COVID-19 on **18 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **365,927** with **7,248** deaths (**CFR: 1.98%**). Out of the total **32,005** currently active cases, **2,025** cases are hospitalized.

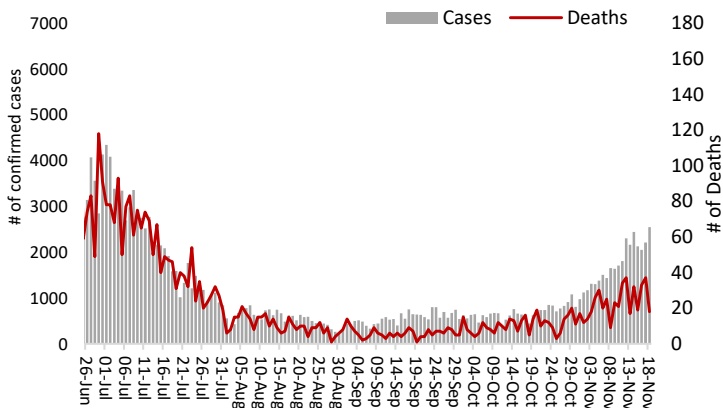

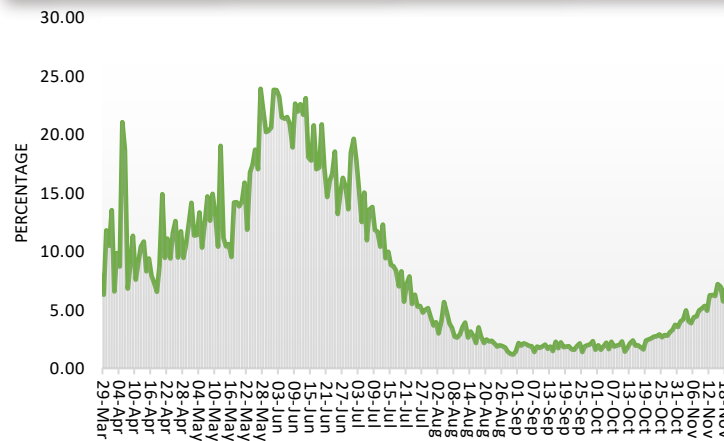


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

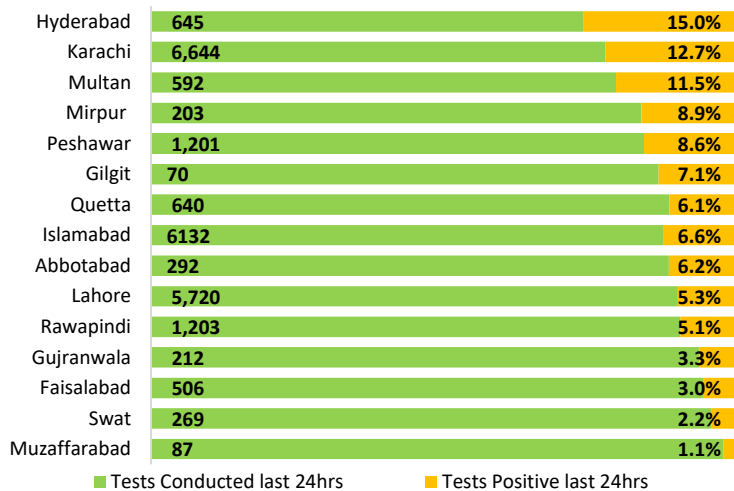
