



#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported **1,772** new cases of COVID-19 on **19 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **524,783** with **11,103** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **35,163** currently active cases **2,872** cases are hospitalized.
