### **MEETING AND COORDINATION**

On 19<sup>th</sup> March 2021, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the honourable Prime Minister Azad Jammu & Kashmir (AJK), H.E. Honorable Minister of Health, Dr Najeeb Naqi Khan, Secretary of Health, Major General Ahsan Altaf Satti, Program Manager (PPM) Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI)/ Primary Health Care (PHC), Dr Bushra Shams were also present during the meeting.

Dr Palitha highlighted the current higher incidence and positivity rate of COVID-19. He stated that these figures are higher than that of the second 2 waves of the epidemic. He discussed about the limited human and other resources. After the meeting WR handed over two (02) Ambulances, Fifteen (15) Motorcycles and an assortment of medical equipment to the honorable Prime Minister AJK.
