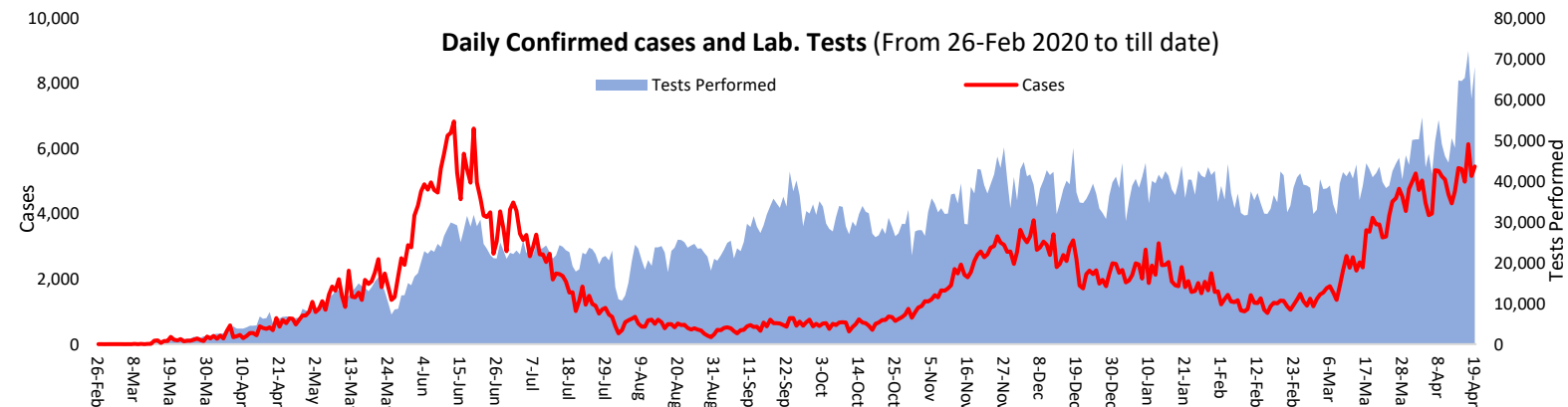

Meeting and Coordination

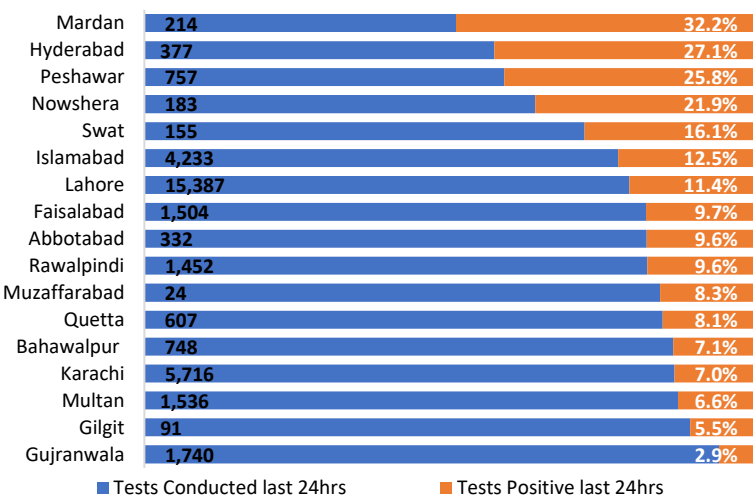


On 20th April 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Incident Manager WHO Pakistan Dr Michael Lukwiya met with the Head of Office, European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations (ECHO) Pakistan, Mr Bernard Jaspers – Fajir. The meeting took place at WHO Country Office Islamabad.

During the meeting Dr Palitha briefed the ECHO envoys on the current COVID-19 situation in the country, on-going COVID-19 response including the vaccination drive and the maintenance of other essential health services. Dr Palitha highlighted the joint work by WHO and partners and the need for further collaboration to support the government to contain the outbreak. At the end, Dr Palitha presented a copy of WHO's daily situation report to Mr Bernard and thanked his team for their valuable support and contributions. In response, Mr Bernard acknowledged the WHO's continuous support to Pakistan during the COVID-19 pandemic.
